Priority #11	Eagle River Greenbelt Multi-use Trail, Esitmated Cost 12M, Federal and State Funds
	This trail will connect the Glenn Highway with the Eagle River Nature Center, about 12 miles in length.
Priority #10	Eagle River High School Stadium Lighting.
Priority #7	Eagle River High School Trail Lighting. This includes the lighting of the trails on the west side of Yosemite Dr.

NOTES:

- (1) There are two priorty 4's, 7's, 9's, and 11's. The numbers were identical statistically.
- (2) The (18) Projects were ranked by members present on a scale of 1 -5, averaged, and prioritized from high to low as shown.
