Girdwood Comprehensive Road and Drainage Improvement Study

Status: Apr 13 2015 - This study will build off an unfinished 2006 drainage study. State grant funding is proposed.

2 Alyeska Creek at Mt Hood Fish Passage (14-54)

Status: Apr 13 2015 - The Girdwood Service Area has provided funding for design and will pursue state grant funding for construction. Survery and base mapping underway.

3 Arlberg Ave Upgrade - Garmisch Rd to Aspen Mountain Rd

Status: Apr 13 2015 - This project has not started. State grant funding is proposed.

4 California Way Connection - Crow Creek Rd to Hightower Rd
