Administration's Report

Cheryl Frasca, OMB Director, reported on first quarter amendment process and walked members through the "AM Support" report that details changes made throughout the amendment process. She reported that the deadline was last Friday for bids in response to the Efficiency RFP and that 7 were determined as responsive.

ASD Report
