Dear Fellow Anchorage Resident:

I am pleased to present the Municipality of Anchorage's Proposed 2008 Capital Improvement Budget (CIB) and Proposed 2008-2013 Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

Every government budget has two parts: the operating budget, which pays for day-to-day services; and the capital budget, which funds public works needs, from roads and snow clearing equipment to public buildings, such as libraries and recreation centers.

As the Municipality continues to deliver essential services as efficiently as possible, we must continue to invest in our city's infrastructure in order to keep our economy healthy and safeguard Anchorage's public safety, transportation and enviable quality of life. This proposed capital budget addresses Anchorage's most basic needs, while providing the means to expand our economy with targeted investments in new economic diversification projects.

We continue to work with Alaska's congressional delegation and the Alaska State Legislature to ensure that Anchorage's essential capital needs are addressed with federal and state funding.

I urge you to review this summary of our community's capital project needs and participate in the budget process as the Anchorage Assembly considers its final action on both the capital and operating budgets. Two public hearings will be held in Assembly Chambers at Loussac Library before the budgets are adopted: October 23 and November 6. In addition, a work session on the capital budget will be held Friday, November 2 at City Hall.
