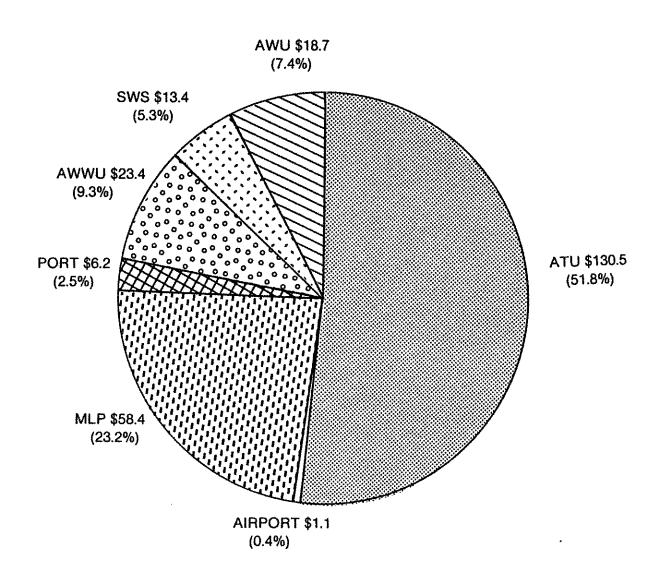
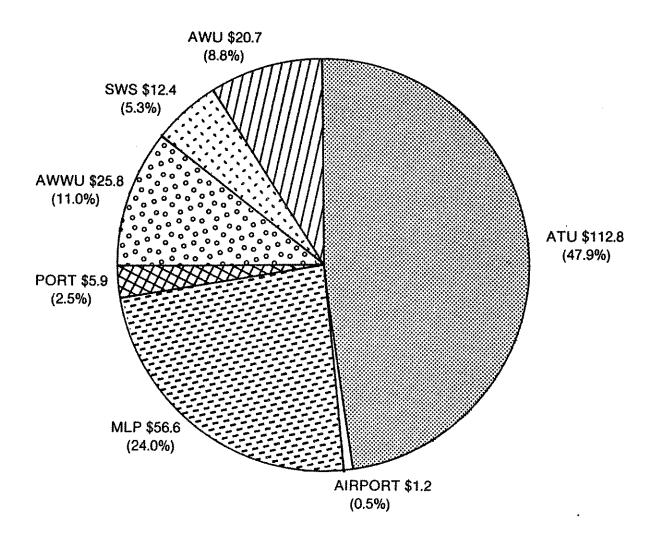
1985 ANCHORAGE PUBLIC UTILITIES

BUDGET EXPENSE SUMMARY (\$235.4 MILLION)



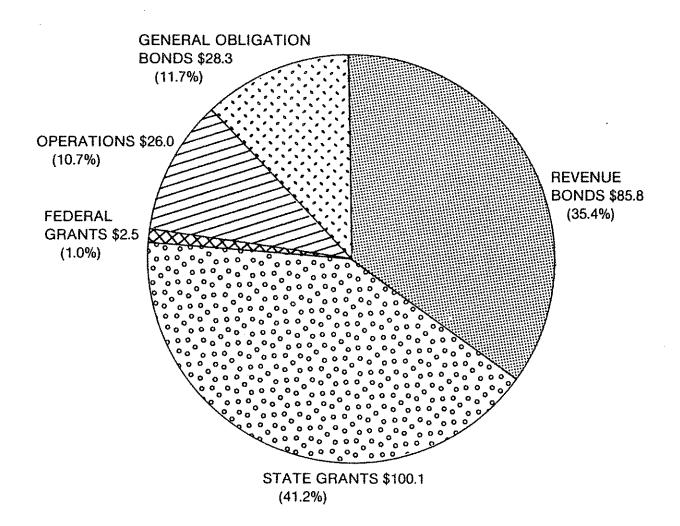

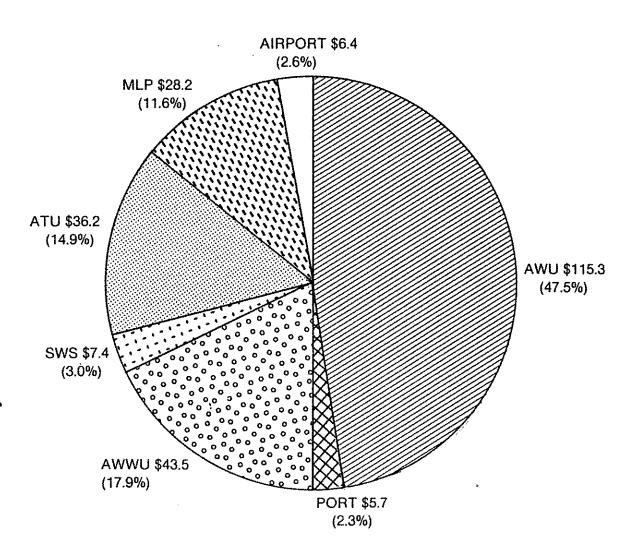

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1985 PUBLIC UTILITIES OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SAID BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented his recommended 1985 Public Utilities Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for the Municipality of Anchorage to the Assembly in accordance with Article XIII of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly reviewed the budgets as presented and made various changes therein; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 1984 and on November 20, 1984 duly advertised public hearings were held in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.04 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the 1985 funds are now ready for appropriation by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Assembly hereby ordains:

- 1. That the 1985 Public Utilities Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Budget as recommended by the Mayor and revised by the Assembly are hereby adopted for the Municipality of Anchorage.
- 2. That the amounts are set forth in the Budgets as revised by the Assembly for the respective departments and/or funds shall be, and hereby are appropriations for the 1985 fiscal year.
- 3. Appropriations for the following Utilities; Operating Budget expenditures are hereby established:
