What is a Maker Night?

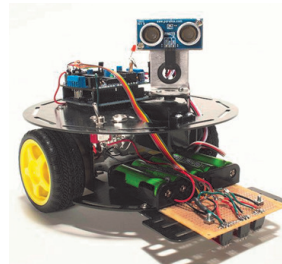
4th floor of the library turns into an Invention Lab.
