Resolution of Support for Challenge Alaska's application for an Alaska Mental Health Transit Grant

WHEREAS, Challenge Alaska is a non-profit corporation in good standing within the State of Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, Challenge Alaska assists in adaptive programs for those individuals with special needs throughout Southcentral Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, Challenge Alaska has a facility in Girdwood where those with special needs are assisted in pursuing their goals; and,

WHEREAS, Challenge Alaska has received non-profit recreation grants from the Girdwood Board of Supervisors for many years in the past, and has been a great asset and partner to the community; and

WHEREAS, Challenge Alaska is now seeking an Alaska Mental Health Trust Transit Grant in order to purchase a new vehicle which will be used to provide transportation to those with special needs to un-served areas and at un-served times, both of which are primary to operations in Girdwood;
