History:

In 1987 an agreement was signed to give Parks & Recreation an encroachment permit to develop a pocket park in the Peterkin Street right of way. In 1990 the community council recommended the park be named Louie G. Mizelle Memorial Park to honor a police officer who lost his life in the line of duty in Mountain View. In 1992 a state representative helped acquire monies to develop the park and development was completed in 1996.
