Turnagain Community Council Resolution on a Project Priority List for 2013 Kiwanis Fish Creek Park Improvements

Whereas, the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Department and the Anchorage Park Foundation have initiated park improvement projects for the Kiwanis Fish Creek Park in Turnagain, based on the Report Card submitted by Turnagain residents in 2011; and

Whereas, the Parks Dept. created a VIP Committee in 2011 with representation from Turnagain Community Council to provide additional input and prioritize project improvements; and

Whereas, the State Legislature has approved funding for improvement projects for Kiwanis Fish Creek Park in both 2011 and 2012; and

Whereas, the Parks Dept. sponsored a Park "Fix-It" event at Kiwanis Fish Creek Park on June 23, 2012, using volunteers and some of the legislative funding for identified park improvements; and

Whereas the VIP Committee met on October 23, 2012, to review and prioritize remaining park improvement projects for the Turnagain Community Council to approve;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Turnagain Community Council:

Supports the Kiwanis Fish Creek Park VIP Committee's recommendation that resurfacing the tennis court is the top priority for park improvement projects to be completed in 2013, with the purchase and installation of a bike rack and restriping of the basketball court to be done as well, depending on funding availability.
