

Tikishla Park

Use Areas

Tikishla Park encompasses 105 acres of natural and developed lands and is located along the Chester Creek Greenbelt. The park consists of four use areas or activity nodes. This includes Tikishla Park (E 20th Ave), Davenport Fields, the Chester Creek Trail, and natural areas.

Tikishla Park (E 20th Ave): Located at the east end of 20th Ave, this area functions as a neighborhood park for residents of Airport Heights. Tikishla Park of E 20th Ave has a 5-12 play area, hockey rink and basketball courts, 2 little league ball fields, a parking lot (20 spaces), trail access, and open space.

Davenport Fields: Davenport Fields is home to the City View Little League. Located off of Lake Otis Blvd, Davenport Fields includes 4 little league fields, a small 5-12 play area, a parking lot (120 spaces), and trail access.

Chester Creek Trail: The Chester Creek Trail is one of Anchorage's most popular paved multi-use trails. The Chester Creek Trail runs through the heart of Tikishla Park with paved spur trails providing access and connections to the neighborhoods.

Natural Areas: Tikishla Park is largely undeveloped natural areas consisting of Middle and South Forks of Chester Creek. Class A wetlands and wildlife habitat. There are seasonal and year-round trails located within these natural areas of the park.
