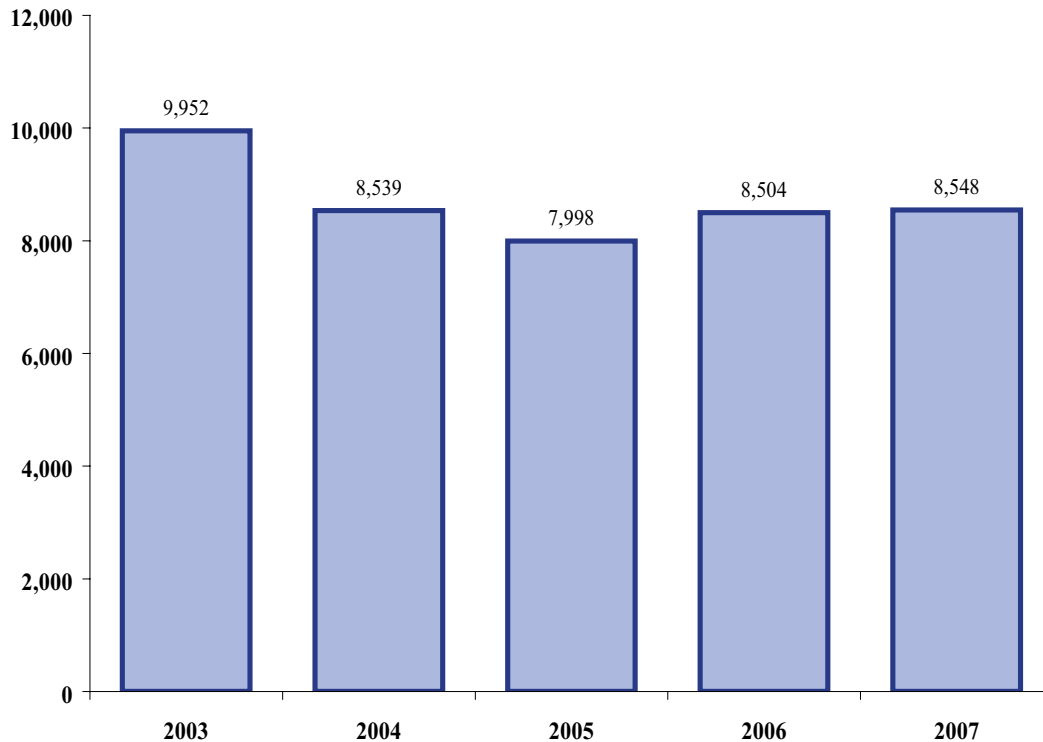

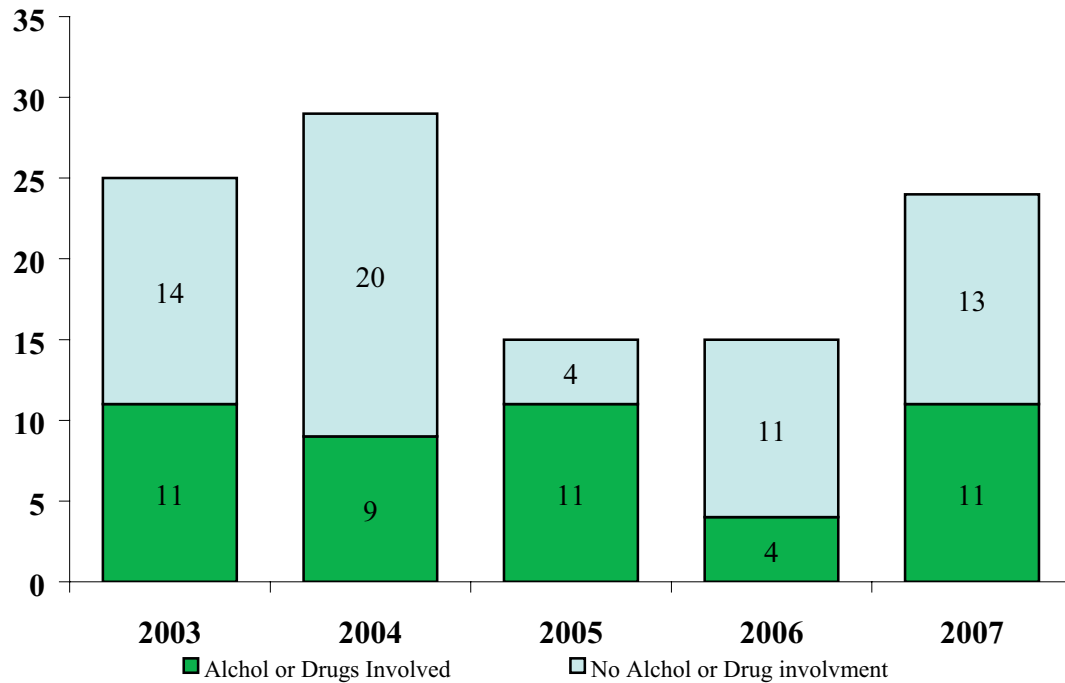

## Alcohol and Drug Involvement known to Police

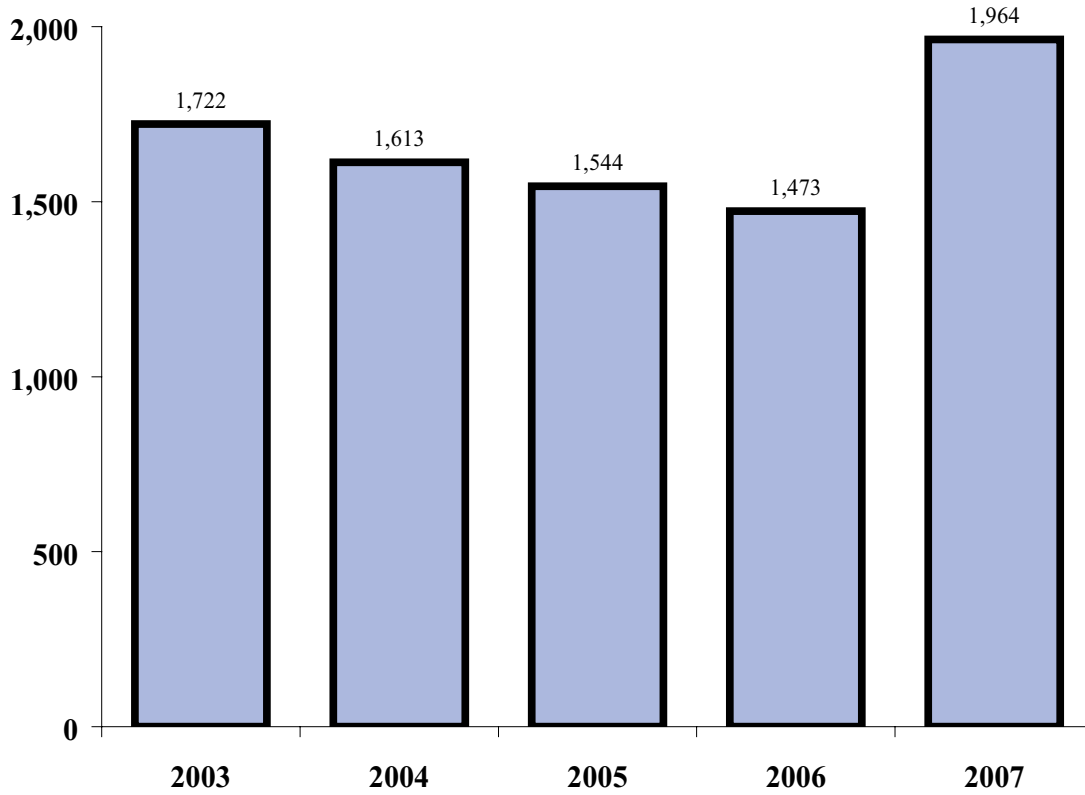

# Traffic Violations

## 2003 - 2007

While the number of fatality accidents within the municipality remains relatively low, injuries occurred in nearly one-fourth of all accidents. Many of the 8,504 motor vehicle accident reports written by the Department last year can be attributed to some of the more serious violations listed below. Officers will continue to focus their attention on violations that are most likely to cause accidents.
