



Recruitment for the Alaska Citizen Review Panel

The Citizen Review Panel is a requirement of the federal Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA).

Membership is composed of volunteer members who meet quarterly and are broadly representative of the state. We are recruiting community members knowledgeable in the child protection system.

Responsibilities include: examine the policies, procedures and practices of state and local agencies and specific cases. Evaluate the extent to which State and local child protection system agencies are effectively discharging their child protection responsibilities. Issue a public report containing a summary of the activities of the panel and recommendations to improve the child protection service system at the State and local levels.

Interested citizens should submit in writing the following information:

- Name and contact information
- Experience in the prevention and treatment of child abuse and neglect.

Requirements include:

- A two year commitment
- A minimum of travel every quarter
- Participation in teleconferences
- Attend and participate in public outreach meetings
- Attend training for the CRP
