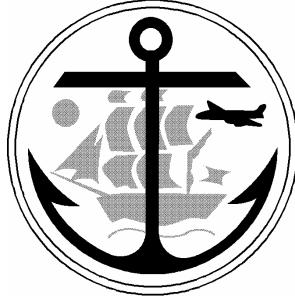

**2004 ASSEMBLY DOCUMENTS ON-LINE**

*More than 300 ordinances and resolutions now available via the Internet*

As part of a continuing effort to make Anchorage Assembly documents more accessible to the general public, the Assembly today announced that more than 300 ordinances and resolutions are now available on the Assembly's web site.

*"We are making strides to provide as many public documents as possible through the web site,"* said Assembly Chair Dick Traini. *"These documents have always been accessible to the public,"* he continued. *"But technology now allows citizens to quickly search through what would amount to piles of paper to find the one document they want."*

From the Assembly web site ([www.muni.org/assembly2/index.cfm](http://www.muni.org/assembly2/index.cfm)) choose "Assembly Resolutions/Ordinances" from the Quick Reference menu. Ordinances and resolutions may be searched using key words. Currently, only documents from 2004 are available on line.
