

# ***SACC*** ***South Addition Community Council***

Dear Mr. Holmes;

The Municipality of Anchorage has asked South Addition Community Council (SACC) to list the capital projects in its region that should be funded and the order of priority. Attached is a chart that compiles the priority ranking of the SACC members for the listed projects, suggestions for additional important projects, and noting projects that ought not to be funded.

From the Municipality's proposed capital projects list SACC's three highest priorities were:

- E Street left-hand turn signal at 15<sup>th</sup> Ave
- 16<sup>th</sup> Ave/A Street- pedestrian activated crossing light
- South Addition pedestrian scale lighting

SACC's additional three highest priorities for funding were:

- Add sidewalks next to street on A and C Streets from 15 Ave to Fireweed
- Underground the utilities in South Addition
- Add Sidewalk on Spenard Road south from Lagoon to Hillcrest

Projects on the Municipal list that SACC's membership opposed funding were:

- Do not restripe the A/C Couplet to 4 lanes
- Do not expand Minnesota northbound from 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- South Addition Alley repaving
