1 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ACKNOWLEDGING THE
2 PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION TO ESTABLISH
3 COMMUNITY COUNCILS FOR MIDTOWN AND CHENEY LAKE/NUNAKA
4 VALLEY; AND STATING THE INTENT TO CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDED
5 BOUNDARIES FOR MIDTOWN AND CHENEY LAKE/NUNAKA VALLEY
6 DISTRICTS AS THEY APPEAR IN THE *COMMUNITY COUNCIL REDISTRICTING*
7 *REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS*, DATED DECEMBER 9, 2002.

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9 WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission, in its December 9, 2002 report *Community*
10 *Council Redistricting - Report and Recommendations*, has recommended the establishment
11 of a community council district to serve the Midtown area and a community council district
12 to serve the Nunaka Valley/Cheney Lake area, including the Ptarmigan Elementary
13 attendance area, once voluntary neighborhood associations from these neighborhoods meet
14 the requirements of subsection 2.40.030B. and request recognition by the Anchorage
15 Assembly as the community councils for these districts;

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17 WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission recommends the district boundaries of the
18 Midtown and Nunaka Valley/Cheney Lake community councils to be as they appear in the
19 December 9, 2002 *Report and Recommendations* and supplemental maps;

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21 WHEREAS, as of the date of introduction of this resolution before the Assembly, no
22 voluntary association from either Midtown or Nunaka Valley/Cheney Lake has yet to qualify
23 for recognition under the requirements of subsection 2.40.030B. and request recognition by
24 the Assembly to become the community council for its district; now therefore,

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26 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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28 **Section 1.** The Anchorage Assembly acknowledges the Planning & Zoning Commission
29 recommendation to establish community councils for Midtown and for Nunaka Valley/
30 Cheney Lake including the Ptarmigan Elementary attendance area once voluntary
31 associations from these neighborhoods meet the requirements of subsection 2.40.030B. and
32 request recognition by the Anchorage Assembly as the community councils for these
33 districts, using boundaries that appear on Map 4 supplemental to the *Community Council*
34 *Redistricting Report and Recommendations*, dated December 9, 2002.

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36 **Section 2.** Until voluntary associations from the Midtown and Nunaka Valley/Cheney Lake
37 neighborhoods meet the requirements of subsection 2.40.030B. and receive recognition by
38 the Anchorage Assembly as community councils, the Midtown and Nunaka Valley/Cheney
39 Lake areas shall continue to receive representation from existing community council
40 districts.

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1 **Section 3.** The Anchorage Assembly intends, when a voluntary association from Nunaka
2 Valley/Cheney Lake or Midtown meets the requirements of subsection 2.40.030B. and
3 requests recognition by the Anchorage Assembly as the community council for its
4 neighborhood, to take into consideration the Planning & Zoning Commission
5 recommendation that the boundaries for each of these community councils should be as they
6 appear on the attached *Map 3 with Nunaka Valley/Cheney Lake* and the attached *Map 6 with*
7 *Midtown*.

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9 **Section 4.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the
10 Anchorage Assembly.
