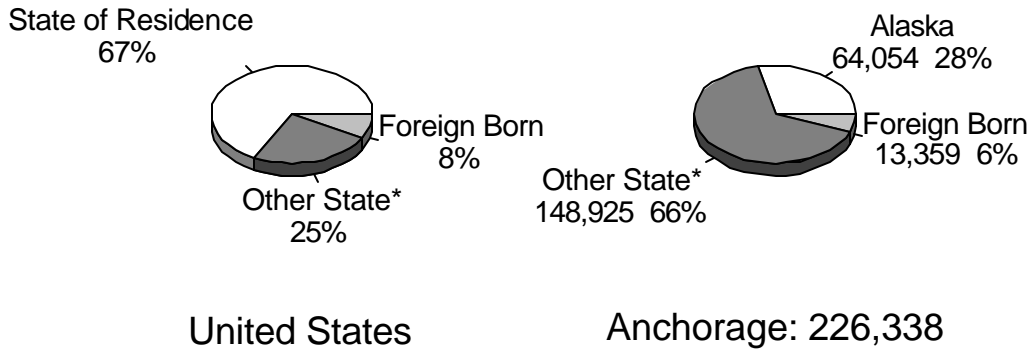


Place of Birth

U.S. and Anchorage - 1990

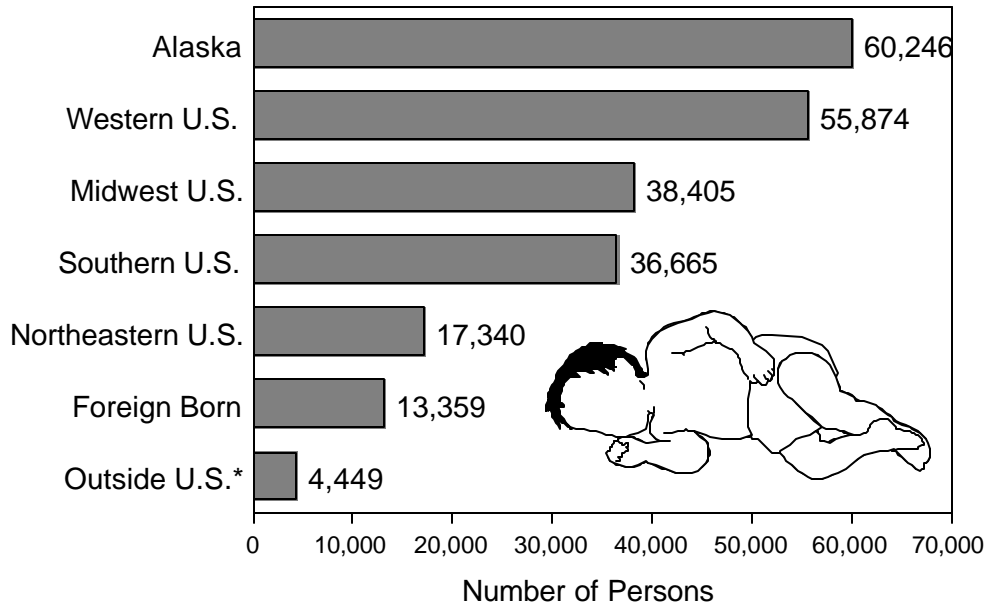

Anchorage Residents - 1990

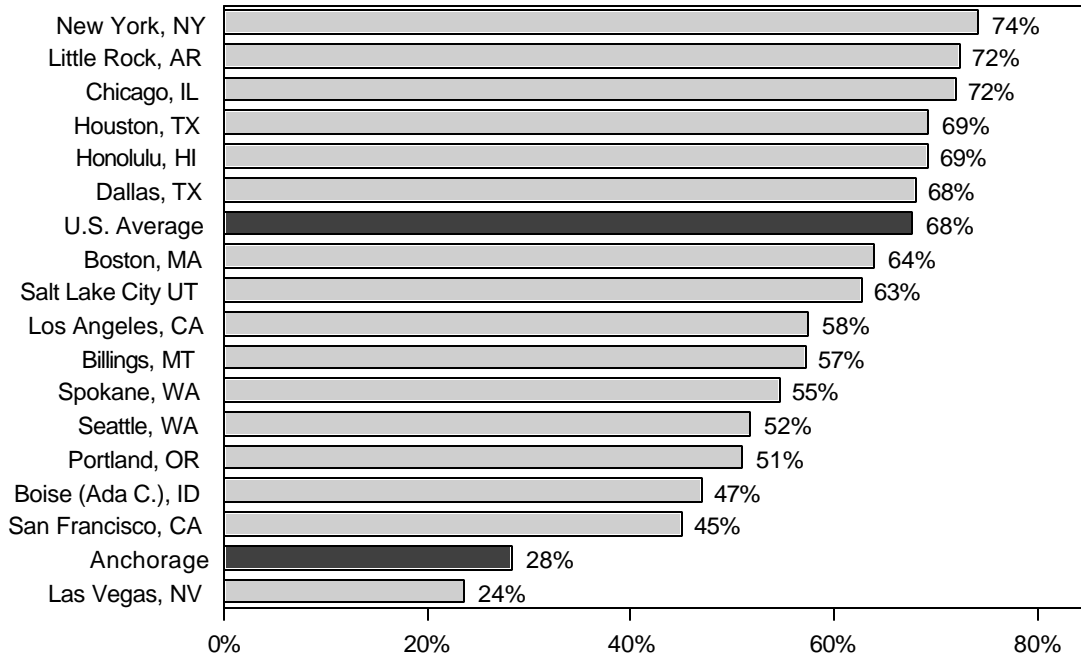

Anchorage & U.S. Cities - 1990

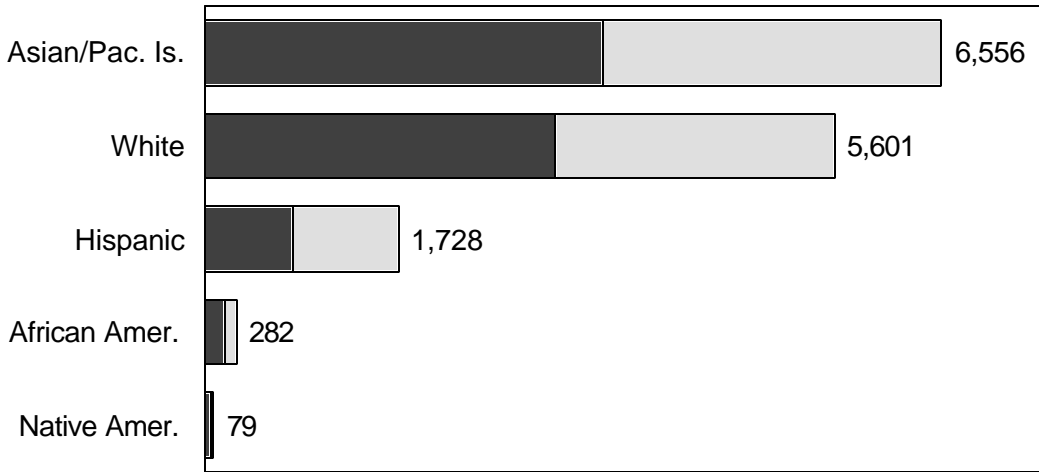

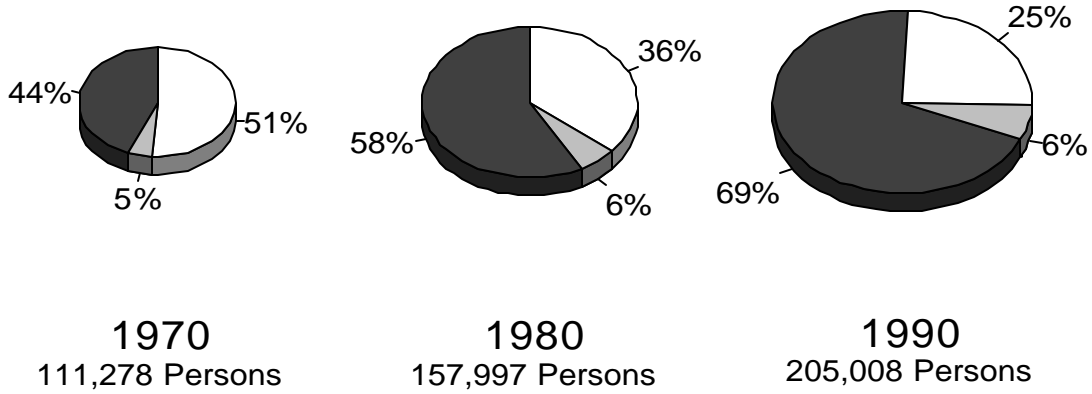
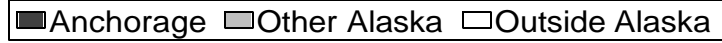

Anchorage Persons 5 Years & Older - 1970, 1980 & 1990

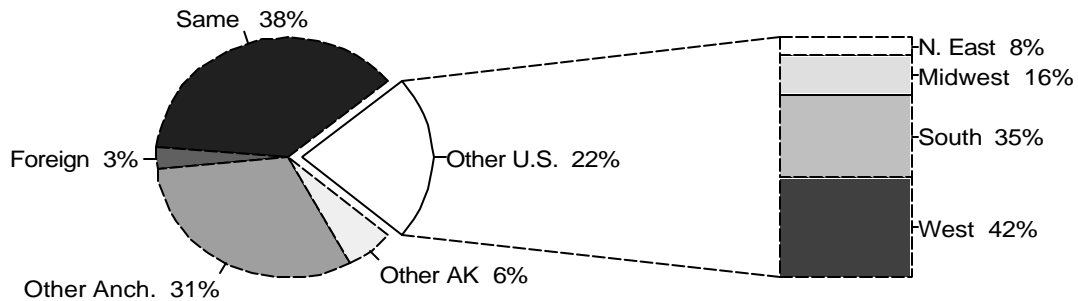

Anchorage Residents 5 Yrs. & Older - 1990

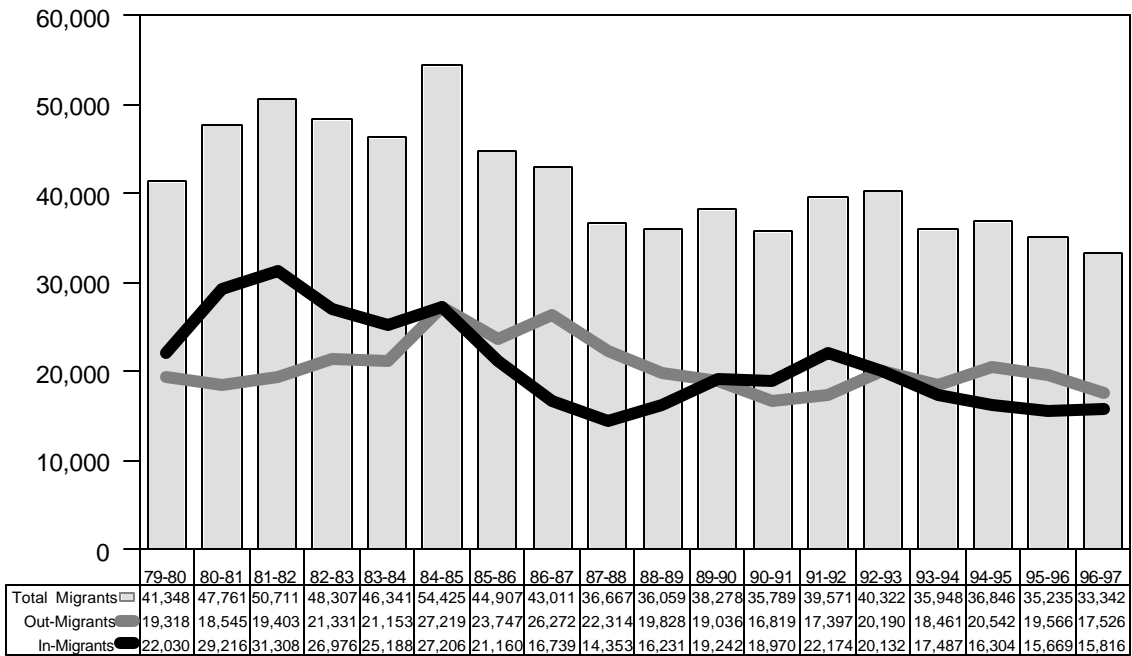

Persons Moving In & Out - 1979-80 to 1996-97

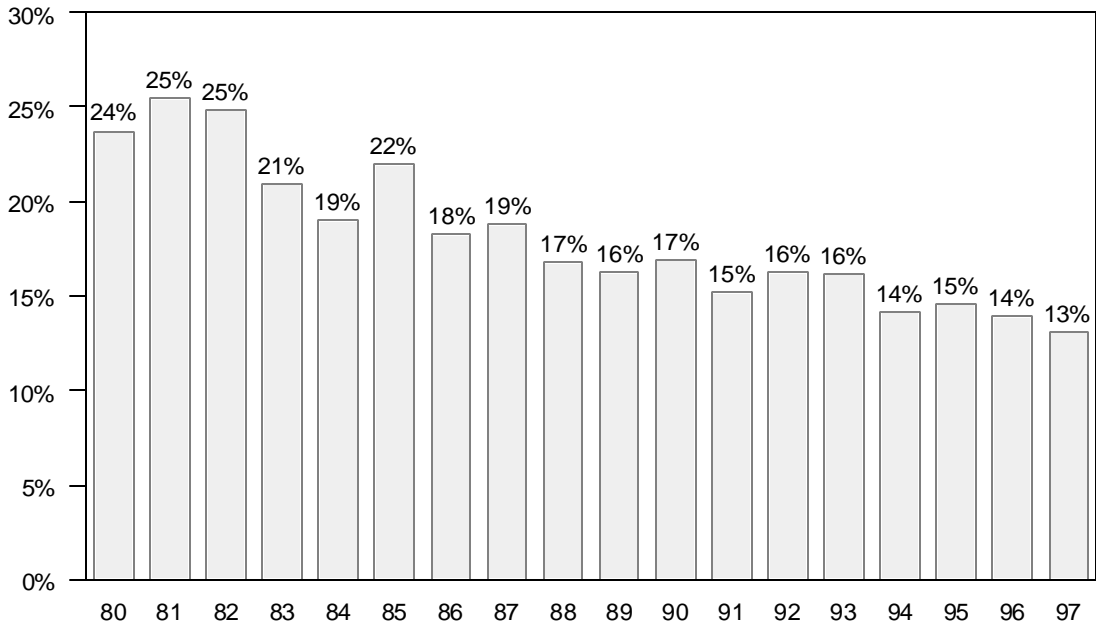

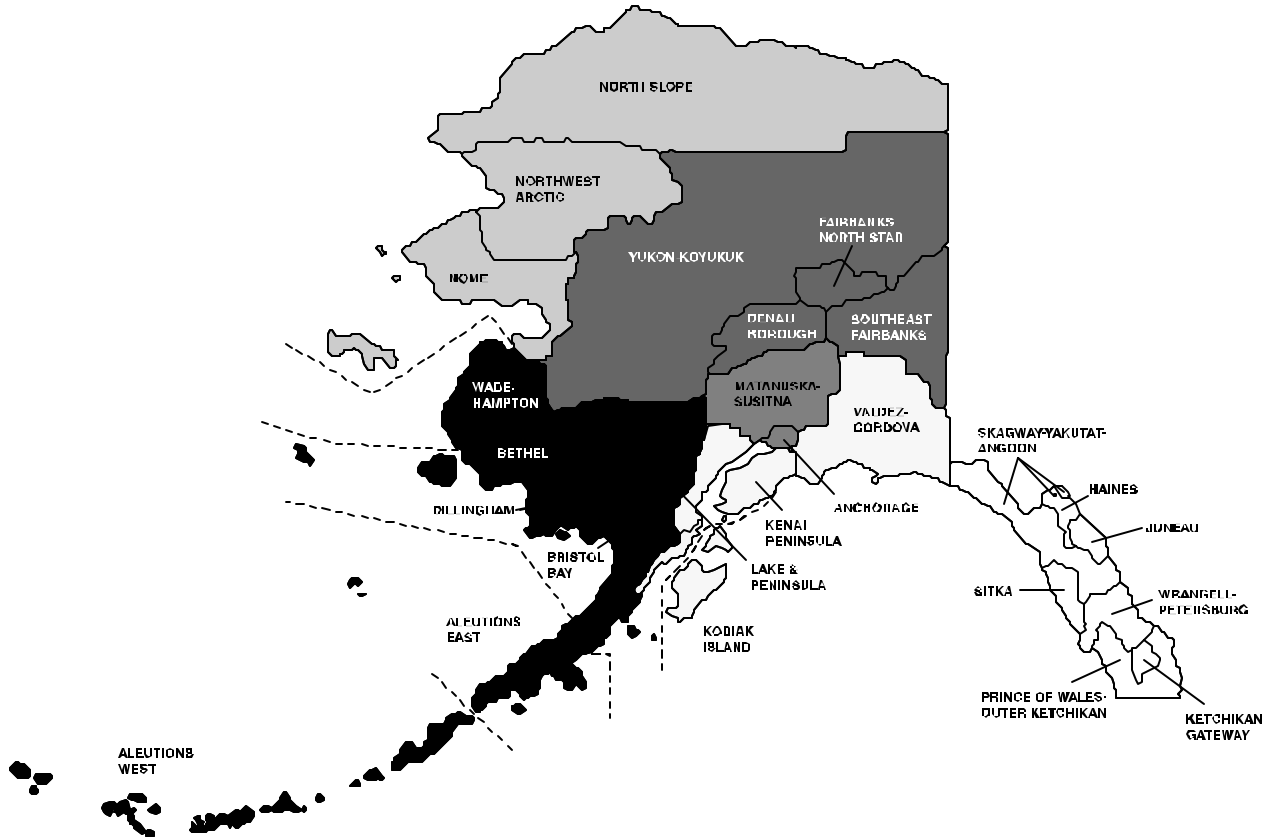

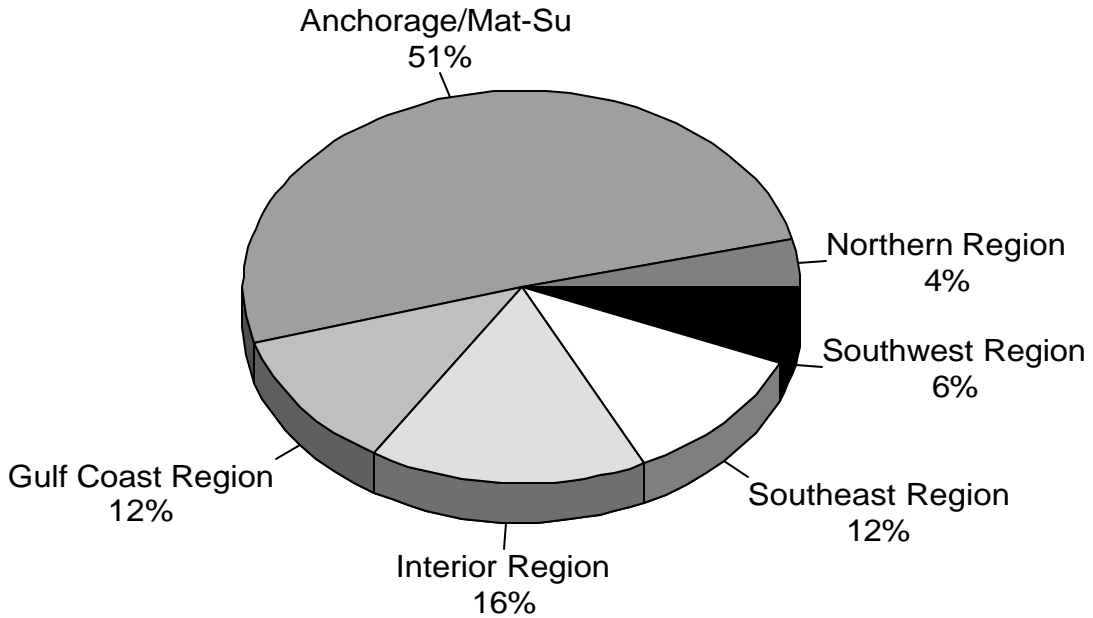

Alaska 1999



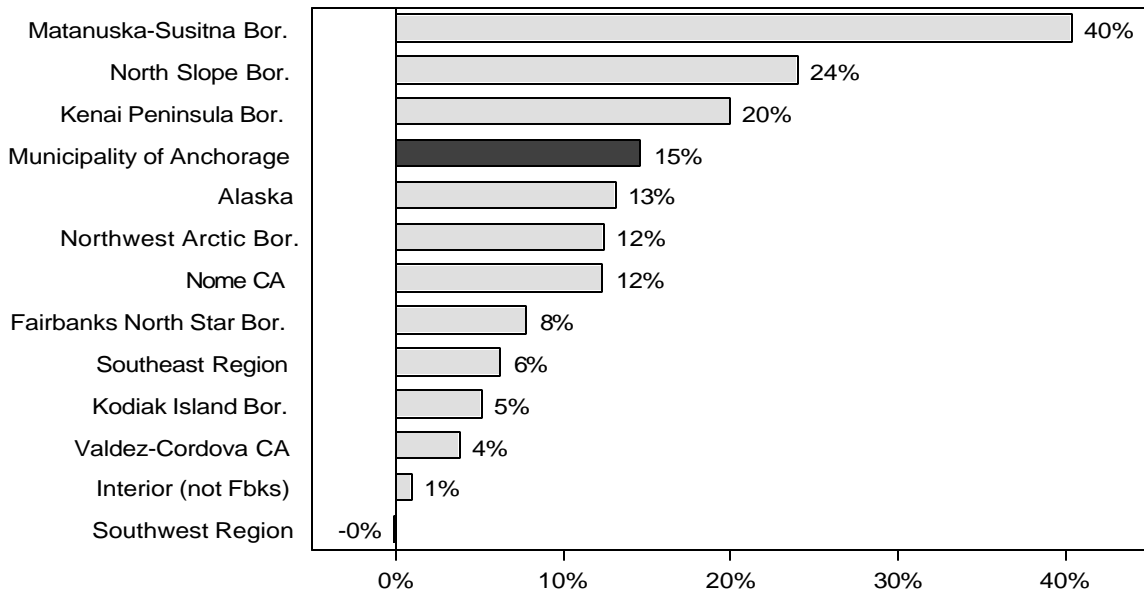
