



ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

MOA Solid Waste Services is now accepting Electronics from Commercial Users for recycling at the Hazardous Waste Center at the Anchorage Regional Landfill location only. We are located at the intersection of Hiland Road and the Glenn Highway. Hours of operation are Tuesday through Saturday, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

- Commercial Users (businesses) are invited to bring in their unusable electronics for recycling for a nominal fee.
- Residential users are encouraged to recycle their old or broken electronics also, but this MOA program has been designed for commercial users only. Fees will be charged as follows:

\$30 - Computer Monitors (CRT's) less than or equal to 19".

\$35 - Computer Monitors (CRT's) greater than 19".

0.50/lb. - All other computer components and office equipment containing circuit boards such as; telephones, adding machines, fax machines, printers, etc.

No Charge - Cables

Businesses: Drop off your outdated or broken electronics for recycling. Electronics contain hazardous components such as lead and mercury that should not go into the landfill. The average computer monitor contains up to five pounds of lead!
