Meeting called to order at 1150.

Dan informed the Tech Board about the Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) Cluster System forum that will be held on 13 December from 11:30 to 2:00. An email will be sent to Chris Birch, Debbie Ossiander, Jennifer Johnson, & Bill Starr inviting them to the AWWU forum, along with the 12 September 07 minutes from the Tech Board.

Dan explained to the Tech Board about the audit done of the On-Site program by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (A.D.E.C.). A private engineer had filed a complaint with that had to be investigated, and A.D.E.C. will send a letter to Dan Roth informing him of the findings.

Linda Kovac gave the Tech Board an update to Title 21, and of the need for the Tech Board to review the wastewater runoff part of the code. Mark Musial suggested forming a committee, which was voted on and approved by the board. Joel Neimeyer, Linda Kovac and Mark Musial will be on the committee and will have their recommendations by January 2008.

The update of the On-Site Wastewater code is on going and Dan will check the State code for stand pipe length above ground, and will call the septic pumpers to check and see if the access for the pump truck must not be more than 20 feet higher than the bottom of the tank. Is this doable without specialized equipment?
