



**Special Land Use Permit for Alcohol Approval Criteria**

1. The proposed use is consistent with the comprehensive plan and all applicable provisions of this title and applicable state and federal regulations.
  - a. The proposed liquor store will be fully contained within the existing Target retail store. Both the proposed liquor store and the existing Target store fit into the Commercial Corridor designation which applies to auto-oriented, low-intensity retail, office, and commercial services along arterial corridors, which support surrounding suburban residential neighborhoods. The addition of a separate entrance liquor store is part of our upcoming reinvestment in our existing Target store. This store remodel, and proposed liquor store, will help us provide our guests with convenient, one-stop shopping where they can pick up all of their items in one trip.
2. The proposed use is consistent with the purpose and intent of the zoning district in which it is located, including any district-specific standards set forth in Chapter 21.04
  - a. This site is currently zoned I-2 Industrial, however is located in the Action 9-2 “targeted area rezone” in the 2040 Land Use plan. The proposed zoning designation is B-3 General Business District. Per chapter 21.04, the general purpose of commercial districts is “...to provide a full range of retail and service establishments...” and “...attract regional and statewide populations, in addition to local residents.” This liquor store will be fully contained within the existing Target retail store that has been operating at this location since 2009. The addition of a liquor store will allow Target to continue to offer guests a convenient one-stop shopping experience.
3. The proposed use is consistent with any applicable use-specific standards set forth in Chapter 21.05.
  - a. This site meets all of the minimum requirements set forth in Chapter 21.05. Liquor stores are a permitted use in B-3 zoned sites. This location meets all of the minimum distance requirements in Chapter 21.05 and all applicable state standards.
4. The site size, dimensions, shape, location, and topography are adequate for the needs of the proposed use and any mitigation needed to address potential impacts.
  - a. The proposed liquor store will be fully contained within the existing Target retail store. All construction will take place within the existing walls of the store, with the exception of the creation of a separate exterior entrance to the liquor store as required under state law. There will be no other impact to the existing site.
5. The proposed use will not alter the character of the surrounding area in a manner which substantially limits, impairs, or prevents the use of surrounding properties for the permitted uses listed in the underlying zoning district.
  - a. The proposed liquor store will be fully contained within the existing Target retail store. There will be no new or additional impact to surrounding properties.
6. The proposed use is compatible with uses allowed on adjacent properties, in terms of its scale, site design, operating characteristics (hours of operation, traffic generation, lighting, noise, odor, dust, and other external impacts).
  - a. The proposed liquor store will be fully contained within the existing Target retail store. All construction will take place within the existing walls of the store, with the exception of the creation of a separate exterior entrance as required under state law. The proposed liquor store will operate under similar hours as the existing Target retail store. There is no expected significant changes in traffic, lighting, noise, or other external impacts.
7. Any significant adverse impacts anticipated to result from the use will be mitigated or offset to the maximum extent feasible.
  - a. The proposed liquor store is not expected to cause any significant or adverse impacts.

8. The proposed use is appropriately located with respect to the transportation system, including but not limited to existing and/or planned street designations and improvements, street capacity, access to collectors or arterials, connectivity, off-site parking impacts, transit availability, impacts on pedestrian, bicycle, and transit circulation, and safety for all modes.
  - a. The proposed site is part of the existing Target store located off of C Street and 100<sup>th</sup> Ave. There is sufficient parking as required. There should be no impacts to any transit type or system.

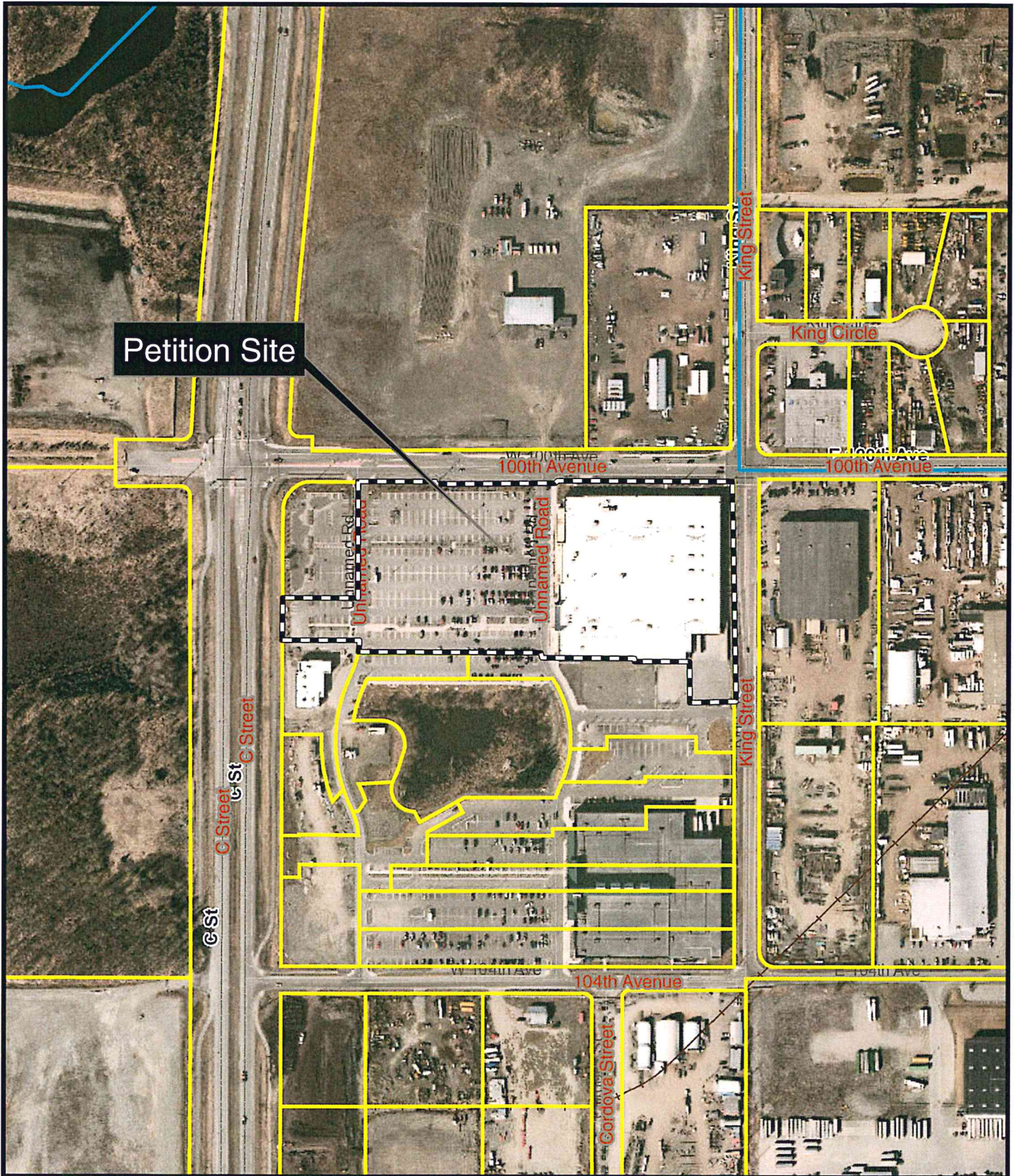
