SUBJECT: Request to Salaries and Emoluments Commission regarding potential stipend for

Youth Representative

In 2017, the Anchorage Assembly approved AO 2017-51(S), As Amended, amending Anchorage Municipal Code to provide for a youth representative to the Assembly. The youth representative must be a resident of the Municipality of Anchorage and should be at least 16 and not more than 19 years old at the time of appointment. Per AMC 2.30.025B.1., the youth representative shall sit with the Assembly during regular and special meetings, may join committees, and participate in worksessions and informal meetings. Although in the past, the youth representatives have typically only attended regular meetings and occasional worksessions.

The commitment required of a youth representative is taxing and may cause undue financial burden to some. I request the Salaries and Emoluments Commission investigate a stipend for the youth representative and make recommendations to the Assembly.

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AMENDMENTS TO THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING A STIPEND FOR THE ASSEMBLY YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE

WHEREAS, the Salaries and Emoluments Commission was established by Anchorage Municipal Charter § 5.08 to "establish the compensation, including salaries, benefits, and allowances, if any, of elected officials"; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Anchorage Assembly approved AO 2017-51(S), As Amended, amending Anchorage Municipal Code to provide for a youth representative to the Assembly. The youth representative must be a resident of the Municipality of Anchorage and should be at least 16 and not more than 19 years old at the time of appointment; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 2.30.025B.1. states the youth representative shall sit with the Assembly during regular and special meetings, may join committees, and participate in worksessions and informal meetings; and

WHEREAS, the cost to attend and participate in Assembly meetings, committee meetings, worksessions and other meetings should not create undue financial burden for the youth representative; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED the Anchorage Salaries and Emoluments Commission recommends amending AMC Section 2.30.025, *Youth representative to the assembly*, to provide for a stipend of:

\$25.00 total per day for regular meetings; and

\$25.00 total per day for special meetings (whose primary purpose is not executive session) lasting more than two hours.
