A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ELECTION COMMISSION THANKING THE 1 2020 ELECTION WORKERS WHO CAME TO WORK AMID THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC 2 AND HELPED TO PRESERVE THE INTEGRITY OF THE APRIL 7, 2020 REGULAR 3 MUNICIPAL ELECTION. 5 WHEREAS, in early March of 2020, the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) appeared in 6 Anchorage, on March 11, 2020, Governor Dunleavy declared a public health emergency, 7 and on March 13, 2020, Mayor Ethan Berkowitz closed municipal facilities in response to 8 9 the coronavirus; and 10 WHEREAS, despite the threat of the coronavirus, Municipal Clerk Barbara Jones, with the 11 support of the Anchorage Assembly Leadership, determined to move forward with the April 12 7, 2020, vote by mail/vote at home election; and 13 14 WHEREAS, over 75 percent of Accessible Vote Center election workers and many Election 15 Center workers declined to work during the April 7, 2020 election; and 16 17 WHEREAS, a dedicated core of remarkable election workers did faithfully come to work for 18 the election, often cross-training and working on multiple teams, wearing gloves and 19 masks, and conscientiously social distancing at the Election Center; and 20 21 WHEREAS, numerous municipal employee-volunteers from multiple departments came to 22 assist; and 23 24 WHEREAS. the election workers processed over 71,000 envelopes and over 140,000 25 ballots cards, resulting in the tremendous success of the 2020 vote by mail/vote at home 26 election. 27 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ANCHORAGE ELECTION 29 **COMMISSION** recognizes and honors: 30 31 ALL OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION WORKERS AND THE ELECTION 32 CORE TEAM 33 34 for an outstanding effort, and celebrates their hard work and dedication to preserving 35 the integrity of the Municipal Election in 2020. 36 37 PASSED AND APPROVED by the Anchorage Election Commission this 5<sup>th</sup> day of 38 39 Chair M anduron 40 41 42 ATTEST: 43 44 45 46 47
