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General Information

- ▶ **Apply early to receive your ballot in time.** Applications should be received in the Municipal Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m. AKDST on **March 28, 2017**. Applications received after **March 28, 2017** will be processed subject to availability of staff and resources until 5:00 p.m. AKDST on April 3, 2016.
- ▶ **Hand-deliver, mail, fax, or scan and email completed vote by mail application to:**

- ▶ **When completing your application be sure to:**
 - **Type or print legibly and use dark ink if you complete the application by hand.**
 - **Provide your complete Municipality of Anchorage residence address.** Your application *will not be processed* if the residence address is left blank or incomplete, or if you submit a PO Box, PSC Box, commercial address, or mail stop.
 - **If your residence does not have an assigned number**, indicate exactly where you live, such as the subdivision name, lot, and block; highway name and milepost; or trailer park name and space number.
 - **If you are registered to vote in Anchorage and you wish to vote while temporarily residing outside of Anchorage**, provide your Anchorage residence address as it appears on your current Alaska voter registration record.
 - **If your Anchorage residence address has changed**, provide your new address on the application.
 - **Provide a telephone number** where we can contact you.
 - **Provide the fax number** where you want to receive your ballot materials.
 - **Provide at least one identifier**, such as voter number, last four digits of your social security number, or date of birth. This information is kept confidential.
 - **Print** a copy of your completed application if you are completing electronically.
 - **Hand-write your signature and date.**
- ▶ **Ballots will be faxed beginning the week of March 20, 2017** and are faxed in the order that applications are received. **If you have not received your ballot by Monday, April 3, 2017, call 907-243-VOTE (8683) before 5:00 p.m. AKDST to obtain a duplicate ballot.**
- ▶ **Return your ballot as soon as possible. Voted ballots must be received by 8:00 p.m. AKDST on Election Day, April 4, 2017.**
