Application to Vote at a Temporary Address - Instructions and Information

- **Type or print legibly and use dark ink.**
- **Provide your complete Municipality of Anchorage residence address.** Your application *will not be processed* if the residence address is left blank, incomplete, or if you submit a PO Box, PSC Box, commercial address, or mail stop.
 - **If your Anchorage residence address has changed**, provide your new address on the application. **This will not update your voter registration.**
- **Provide a telephone number and/or email address**, so we can contact you if necessary.
- **Provide the temporary mailing address** where you want to receive your ballot package.
- **Indicate** what mailing address should be used if there is a Mayoral Runoff Election on May 11, 2021.
- **Provide at least one identifier:** voter number, last four digits of your social security number, or date of birth. This information is kept confidential.
- **Provide your handwritten signature and date.** **A computer generated (electronic) signature is not acceptable.**
- **Drop off, mail, fax, or email** completed application to MOA Elections:
 - **Drop off:** In the secure drop box (shared with the MOA Treasury Department) behind City Hall, 632 West 6th Avenue (access from 7th Avenue), Anchorage, AK 99501

- **Apply early to receive your ballot package at a temporary mailing address.** Completed applications must be received no later than **5:00pm AKDT on March 30, 2021.**
- **Ballot packages will be mailed on March 16, 2021.**
 - If your application is submitted by March 5th, then your ballot package will be mailed to your temporary address on March 16th.
 - If your application is submitted between March 6th and March 30th, a replacement ballot package will be mailed to your temporary address within two business days of our receiving your application, beginning March 16, 2021.
 - **If you have not received your ballot package at your temporary address by March 23rd (having submitting your application prior to March 16, 2021) or within 7 days of submitting your application after March 16, 2020;** call 907-243-VOTE (8683) or email elections@AnchorageAK.Gov before 5:00 pm AKDT on Monday, April 5, 2021, to learn about other options for you to vote.
- **Return your voted ballot as soon as possible.** Voted ballots must be **postmarked no later than Election Day April 6, 2021**, and received by the Clerk's Office no later than **noon AKDT on Friday, April 16, 2021.**

If you will not be available to receive mail at a mailing address between March 16th and April 5th, please email elections@AnchorageAK.Gov or call 907-243-VOTE (8683) as soon as possible to learn about other options for you to vote.
