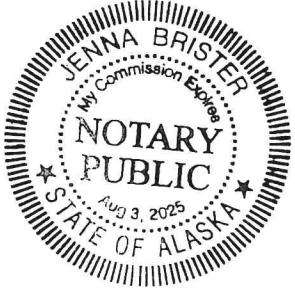

SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS

Fifty-four years' experience in management, to include serving as Director of Contracts, Logistics, and Administration with the Nation's only non-federally owned commercial space launch provider; large scale logistics management in the U.S. and overseas with the military; management of multi-million dollar projects as a supervisor with the Alaska oil industry; as a contractor at remote Air Force sites; as a manager with one of the largest architectural and engineering firms in Alaska; as a construction and professional services contracting manager with various State of Alaska agencies; and as an owner of a consulting firm providing professional and technical services to the aerospace industry in Alaska.

SUPERVISION AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT

Served as the Director of Contracts, Logistics, and Administration for the Alaska Aerospace Corporation, supervising two subordinates. Responsible for over \$100 million in federal and state contracts. Developed detailed procedures to control and manage contractor expenditure of labor and material in support of federal rocket launch activities at the Pacific Spaceport Complex-Alaska.

Managed the Procurement Section of the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority and the Alaska Energy Authority, supervising two subordinates. Responsible for all procurement activities for the design/construction/maintenance of AIDEA/AEA owned and constructed capital facilities throughout the state. Responsible for approximately 100 grants and contracts valued at over \$250 million.

Managed the Contracting/Project Management Branch, FMD/DMVA, supervising four subordinates. Responsible for energy management and the contracting for minor design/construction/maintenance of Army National Guard facilities throughout the state. Responsible for implementation of energy saving measures that resulted in a 3% reduction in energy costs per year for 200 state facilities.

Managed the contracting section for the Division of Energy, supervising one subordinate. Responsible for over 130 federal and state grants and contracts valued in excess of \$30 million.

Supervised twelve personnel as the Manager, Project and Construction Services in Anchorage, Alaska for ASCG Incorporated. Responsible for project management activities for the Resources, Geographic Information Systems and Project Management groups. Established procedures to monitor over 350 company projects valued in excess of \$200 million for progress and cost status.

Supervised nine personnel as the North Slope Regional Manager in Barrow, Alaska for ASCG Incorporated. Expanded the office from four to nine personnel and was responsible for project management activities in support of projects valued at \$22 million, resulting in a 17% profit for FY92.

Managed the ARCO Alaska Construction Support Group at Prudhoe Bay. Supervised two subordinates and a total of 24 contract employees. Responsible for verifying design contractor material takeoffs, and the request, receipt, storage, issue and final disposition of all material required in support of Prudhoe Bay facilities construction projects.

LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT

Coordinated ARCO Alaska transportation services, to include household goods movements, air freight, truckload and less-than-truckload movements. Served as work leader for three technicians. Developed Transportation Procedures that standardized operations within the department.

Commanded a 500-soldier battalion providing combat logistic support (medical, transportation, maintenance and material services) to all US Army combat forces in Alaska. Consistently provided units with an operational equipment readiness rate that exceeded 91% under harsh arctic conditions.

Coordinated and implemented all the logistics planning for three arctic military exercises (Brim Frost '83, '85 and '87) involving over 10,000 individuals from all elements of the US and Canadian Armed Forces.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Managed the Operations and Maintenance contract for Space Mark Incorporated at Galena Air Force Station, Alaska. Supervised six subordinates with a total of 58 employees. Responsible for administration; quality control; facility engineering and maintenance; power, heat, water production and sewage treatment; vehicle maintenance; dormitory and food service operations; material supply and control and fuel storage; airfield, aircraft barrier and Fire Department operations; and environmental monitoring and restoration activities. Contract value was in excess of \$22 million over five years.

Served as the Implementation Coordinator for the ARCO Materials and Purchasing System (AMPS) Project. This \$6 million software-based project was implemented on time and within budget in May 1989. Served as the Project Manager for the ARCO North Slope Construction and Investment Recovery (ANSCIR) Project, a \$1 million follow-on to the AMPS Project.
