SUBJECT: Response to Observer Complaint Re Time Differences on Computer Monitors

Thank you for your complaint filed April 5, 2022. In your complaint, you stated that the two monitors used in the adjudication area display different times and are not “synced” – you note the times are different by 6 minutes and 10 seconds. We agree.

The two computers to which the monitors are attached are controlled internally and are not attached to the internet. Therefore, the computers do not receive consistent updating of the time, such as is available on most cell phones.

We appreciate the opportunity to provide this information that supports that the scanning, adjudication, and tabulation system is not connected to the internet.
