 petition may be sent. The application form shall include space for each contact person to provide optional
 phone and facsimile numbers, and an email address. The two contact persons shall be considered sponsors;

There is established in the legislative branch of the municipality the office of inspector general. The inspector general is appointed by the assembly and serves at the pleasure of the assembly. The term of office, powers and duties of the inspector general shall be prescribed by ordinance. The jurisdiction, power and duties of the inspector general include acts and omissions of employees and agents of the Anchorage Police Department.
