## PROPOSITIONS

### **Proposition C**

This proposition would create a new Turnagain Arm Police Service Area (TAPSA).

The service area would consist of all areas of the Municipality not located within a service area with police powers as of May 4, 2017. The communities of Rainbow, Indian, Bird Creek, Portage, and the northern portion of Crow Creek Road outside the Girdwood Valley Service Area would be included in the new TAPSA.

The service area would be empowered to provide police services for the area. The mill rate of taxes levied from the area for purposes of providing police protection services shall not exceed 0.5 mills in any calendar year, beginning with the 2017 tax levy, or \$50 per \$100,000 of assessed value. Unused taxes collected in one year would roll over to the following year, and could result in reduced future levies.

Funds collected in the service area would initially be used to pay the Anchorage Police Department, on a fee-for-service basis, to investigate crimes that occur within TAPSA. Another provider could be selected on a future date. Funds would not be used to provide for regular patrols or regular response to accidents on the Seward Highway. The service area would be supervised and administered by the Anchorage Police Department.

### **Proposition B**

#### Expansion of the Girdwood Valley Service Area

This proposition expands the boundaries of the Girdwood Valley Service Area (GVSA) to include several parcels of municipal land currently managed by the Heritage Land Bank. The parcels are substantially as depicted on the map provided with this ballot. The Winner Creek hand tram at Four Corners and portions of the Virgin Falls, Abe's, and California Creek trails are located on the parcels that would be incorporated into the GVSA.

Expansion will permit the GVSA to provide services to the areas incorporated. The maximum attainable rate in the GVSA is currently 6.0 mills and will not change.

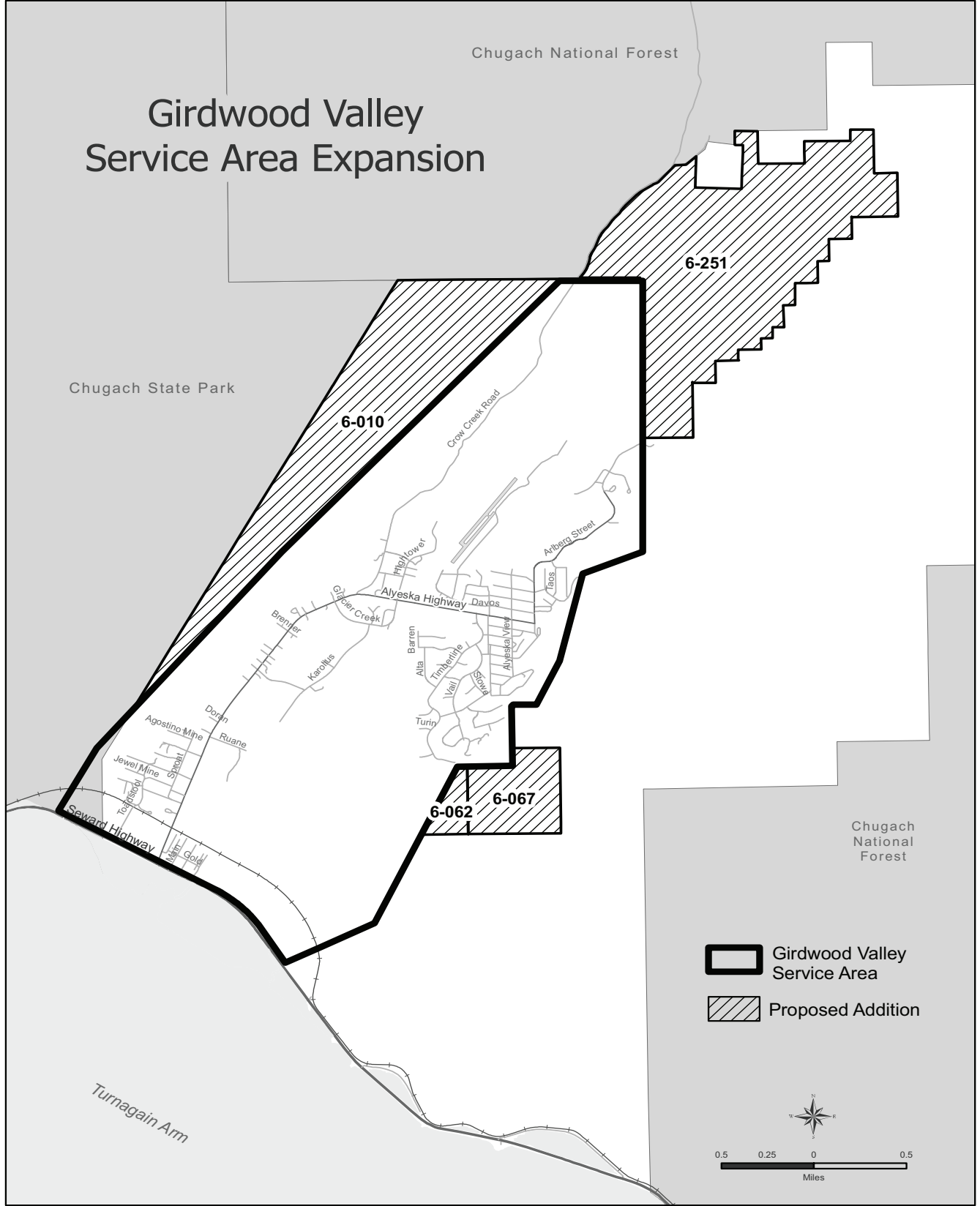
