Upon passage of this proposition, a five member board of supervisors will be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Assembly. The supervisors shall administer the service area until the next regular election at which time supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Limited road maintenance services within the service area shall commence on January 1, 1986, and shall terminate on December 31, 1988, unless the service area is perpetuated in the manner provided by law.

This proposition will be effective only if the ballot proposition to abolish the Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area is approved by a majority of those voting on the question at the October 1, 1985 regular election. (AO 85-148).




