Shall Anchorage incur debt and issue general obligation bonds not to exceed Fifteen Million Dollars (\$15,000,000) for planning, designing, acquiring property for, equipping, rehabilitating and constructing road, storm drainage and related capital improvement projects in the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area? The bonds shall be paid first from individual and business property (general ad valorem) taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area or from assessments against property specially benefitted and be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the Municipality.
