ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE ANCHORAGE MAYOR AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Commission believes the mayor should receive the same parking benefits as other executive/non-represented employees of the Municipality and access to a municipal vehicle; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Anchorage Salaries and Emoluments Commission that the compensation for the mayor elected or re-elected after passage and approval of this resolution, shall be as follows:

Section 1. Salary:

The mayor's salary shall be \$145,392.00, as set by Resolution 2020-1, As Amended.

Section 2. Health Benefits:

The mayor shall be eligible to participate in the same health plan and receive an equal contribution towards their health benefits as received by executive and non-represented employees. Any contribution towards health benefits shall not be included in the base salary.

<u>Section 3. Other Benefits.</u> The mayor shall be eligible to participate in and receive the same parking benefits as executive and non-represented City Hall Employees and access to a take-home vehicle made available from the Maintenance and Operations Department, Fleet Management Division.

<u>Section 4. Retirement Benefits.</u> The mayor is entitled to retirement benefits the same as other executive employees.

Section 5. Effective Date: This resolution shall be in effect immediately upon passage and approval and shall remain in effect until changed in accordance with Section 5.08 of the Anchorage Municipal Charter
