## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR No. 2025-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY CALLING UPON THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO HOLD AN ANNUAL YOUTH VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE TO ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION IN REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

**WHEREAS**, more than 10k students attend Anchorage high schools, according to the National Center for Education Statistics; and

**WHEREAS**, voting in local, state and federal elections is a core right, an obligation of citizenship and a primary vehicle to ensure government is built by and for the people;

WHEREAS, data from Pew Research Center indicates that people between the ages of 18 and 35 are now as large a force as the baby-boom generation, comprising more than 31 percent of the overall electorate; and

WHEREAS, after historically high youth voter turnout of over 50% in the 2020 presidential contest, the Center for Information and Research on Civic Learning and Engagement estimates that only 42% of youth (ages 18-29) voted in 2024; and

**WHEREAS,** Anchorage's local government decisions affect crucial issues like education, public safety, and the economy, making it necessary for young adults to be informed and engaged in the electoral process; and

**WHEREAS**, the school district plays a critical role in encouraging civic engagement by providing students with the knowledge and resources necessary to become informed and active participants in voting and giving them a voice in politics; and

**WHEREAS,** voting is a civic duty and efforts should be made to ensure eligible youth are made aware of it; and

WHEREAS, past efforts to immerse young adults in Anchorage have shown that accessible voter registration opportunities increase turnout and long-term participation in local elections; and

**WHEREAS**, 3,988 Anchorage School District students in grades 6-12 cast ballots in the fall 2024 Anchorage Youth Vote mock election; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1971, the 26th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution was adopted, lowering the voting age to 18; and
