

This is a brief update from our last joint Assembly and School Board meeting on the implementation of AR No. 2025-46.

In January, ASD launched its first Civics Education Week and carried out a districtwide, student-supported voter registration effort across our comprehensive high schools.

Since then, more than 300 students have been registered to vote with support from staff and community partners, and schools shared nonpartisan information aligned to the resolution to support student engagement in the local election process.

We continue to work with partners such as the League of Women Voters to support and expand this work.
