Dear Mr. Armstrong,

I am pleased you have accepted the executive position of Chief Equity Officer (position 30008817) with the Office of the Mayor. Your executive appointment begins April 26, 2021.

Your salary will be based on an annual salary of \$115,003.20 (\$55.29 per hour) and is paid on a bi-weekly basis. This is a salaried position and as such is exempt from the minimum wage and overtime provisions of the Federal Fair Labor Standard Act. You will serve in an appointed capacity at the pleasure of the Mayor.

On an annual basis beginning April 26, 2021, you will receive eighty (80) hours of non-cashable leave in accordance with Anchorage Municipal Code (3.30.174.J).

In accordance with the Anchorage Municipal Code (3.30.173), executive employees shall submit a resume prior to hire or appointment. Under Municipal policy, your resume will become a public record and be included within your personnel file. In addition, your appointment is subject to confirmation by the Municipal Assembly.
