Subject: COOPERATIVE PURCHASE FROM THUNDERCAT TECHNOLOGY, LLC (THUNDERCAT) THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS (OMNIA) CONTRACT #R250609 FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A REAL TIME CRIME CENTER (RTCC) AUDIO VISUAL (A/V) SYSTEM FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE (MOA), ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT (APD), (NOT TO EXCEED (NTE) \$598,998.10).

APD requests approval to enter into a contract with ThunderCat in an amount NTE \$598,998.10 for the purchase and installation of a fully integrated A/V system for the RTCC.

The RTCC will provide APD with a centralized location for receiving, reviewing, and displaying information used to support real-time situational awareness, operational coordination, and investigative activities. The proposed A/V system includes a 6-by-2 video wall with a spare display, an 86-inch conference-area display, video processing and distribution equipment, workstation and conferencing inputs, failover capabilities, touch-panel controls, audio processing, ceiling speakers, video-conferencing integration, equipment racks, cabling, and related hardware. The purchase also includes project management, engineering, installation, programming, system commissioning, user training, freight, system documentation, manufacturer support, warranty coverage, and service support. The A/V system will be furnished as a turnkey solution and includes an air-gapped control and video-streaming network designed to support the operational and security requirements of the RTCC.

OMNIA issued RFP #25-06 Technology Solutions, Products, and Services in June 2025, with proposals opened on August 7, 2025. OMNIA Contract #R250609, awarded to ThunderCat, became effective March 1, 2026, for an initial three-year term through February 28, 2029. The contract permits state and local governmental entities and other eligible public agencies registered with OMNIA to purchase products and services under the competitively solicited contract.

The quoted purchase price, including all A/V equipment, freight, project management, engineering, installation, programming, commissioning, user training, system documentation, manufacturer support, warranty coverage, and related service support, is \$598,998.10. OMNIA Contract #R250609 pricing reflects an overall discount of approximately 1.86% from the quoted list price of \$610,348.16, representing savings of \$11,350.06. The purchase will provide APD with a complete turnkey A/V system for the RTCC. Funding for this purchase will be provided through the Federal/State Fine and Forfeiture Fund.

Based upon the above information and the attached Department Memorandum, it is recommended that the Assembly approve this Cooperative Purchase request from ThunderCat through OMNIA Contract #R250609 for the purchase and installation of a fully integrated A/V system for the RTCC in an amount not to exceed \$598,998.10.

The APD proposed project includes installation of a fully integrated AV system consisting of a video wall, conference room display, video processing and distribution equipment, audio system, video conferencing capabilities, user control interfaces, equipment rack, cabling, and all required programming, installation, commissioning, training, and project management services. The purchase also includes manufacturer support and warranty services to ensure ongoing system reliability.

Utilizing the OMNIA Partners cooperative contract R250609 (expires February 28, 2029) provides a competitively solicited procurement method while delivering a turnkey solution that meets the operational needs of the RTCC.
