AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION ...

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Utility Commission was formed on September 24, 2019 by the Assembly's passage and approval of AO 2019-113(S);

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Utility Commission ramped up as the Mayor proposed appointees to the ten seats, and held its initial meeting

WHEREAS, The Commission has diligently reviewed its mission and purpose, composition, and evaluated actual and potential challenges to fullfill its Code mandates; and

WHEREAS, the Commission sent a letter to the Assembly recommending changes to the formation ordinance and Code provisions governing its composition and activities; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.70.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.70.070 - Stormwater utility commission.

- A. There is established a stormwater utility commission consisting of <u>nine</u> [NO LESS THAN TEN] members. Commission members shall include or represent the following areas:
 - 1. <u>A</u> [ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A] member in good standing of the Alaska Bar with experience in utility matters;
 - 2. <u>A</u> [ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A] registered professional engineer in Alaska [WITH EXPERIENCE IN UTILITY MATTERS];
 - 3. A hyrdrologist [ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A] or other field related to stormwater management;
 - 4. <u>A</u> [ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A] representative of a commercial or industrial customer in the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area (ARDSA);
 - 5. <u>A</u> [ONE] member <u>of</u> [EACH FROM] a road service area board in <u>one</u> [EACH] of the following areas:
 - a. Anchorage Hillside as defined in the Hillside District
 Plan that is outside of the Anchorage Roads and
 Drainage Service Area (ARDSA), or [PLUS]

- <u>b.</u> the Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Limited Road Service Area;[,]
- 6. **Two [THREE]** members who are residents of the ARDSA; and
- 7. Two members [SHALL BE] chosen at large.
- B. In addition to the general responsibilities set forth in section 4.70.010D., the commission shall:
 - Conduct a public hearing(s), report, and make recommendations to the mayor and assembly regarding the utility's:
 - a. Application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity and subsequent modifications,
 - b. Proposed stormwater utility service area boundary,
 - c. Scope of services and service level,
 - d. Rate structure,
 - e. Stormwater management master plan, and
 - f. Capital improvement plan;
 - Conduct public hearings when deemed appropriate on any other matters pertaining to formation and establishment of the new stormwater utility and provide a report and recommendations to the mayor and assembly;
 - 3. Review and make recommendations regarding drainage management practices, services, rates, and regulations; and
 - 4. When appropriate, recommend the assembly retain consultant services or procure studies or surveys.
- C. The manager of the Watershed Management Section of the Project Management and Engineering Department, or designated staff of the section, shall be the executive secretary and technical advisor to the commission and provide administrative support.
- D. The manager of the Watershed Management Section of the Project Management and Engineering Department, or designee to provide administrative support, shall notify Community Councils of openings on the commission and request recommendations for candidates.
- E. The sunset provisions in section 4.05.150 shall not apply to this commission.
