AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED PLANT REPLACEMENT IMPROVEMENT SURCHARGE MECHANISM BY THE ANCHORAGE WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY FOR SUBMISSION TO THE REGULATORY **COMMISSION OF ALASKA.**

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WHEREAS, Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) completed 2021 Test Year Plant Replacement Improvement Surcharge Mechanism (PRISM) calculations for Anchorage Water Utility (AWU) and Anchorage Wastewater Utility (ASU);

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WHEREAS, the PRISM regulations under Alaska Administrative Code, Title 3. Chapter 52 (3 AAC 52) allow water and wastewater utilities to establish a surcharge to recover capital related costs associated with eligible plants placed in service between general rate cases.

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. AWWU shall submit a request for a PRISM tariff rate to the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) for AWU. The PRISM tariff rate requested by AWWU shall be 1.98 percent of each customer's billed revenue which is supported by the 2021 Test Year PRISM calculations and included in the Proposed 2023 Operating Budget for AWU. This ordinance is requesting approval to submit to the RCA in accordance with the rates in the Approved 2023 Operating Budget for AWU.

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AWWU shall submit a request for a PRISM tariff rate to the Regulatory Section 2. Commission of Alaska (RCA) for ASU. The PRISM tariff rate requested by AWWU shall be 0.84 percent of each customer's billed revenue which is supported by the 2021 Test Year PRISM calculations and included in the Proposed 2023 Operating Budget for ASU. This ordinance is requesting approval to submit to the RCA in accordance with the rates in the Approved 2023 Operating Budget for ASU.

REPLACEMENT IMPROVEMENT SURCHARGE MECHANISM BY THE ANCHORAGE WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY FOR SUBMISSION TO THE REGULATORY COMMISSION OF

ALASKA.

In accordance with AMC 26.10.035, the Administration is submitting an ordinance concurrent with this memorandum for review and approval by the Anchorage Assembly of submission of a proposed Plant Replacement Improvement Surcharge Mechanism (PRISM) by the Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) based on the results of 2021 Test Year calculation to the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA).

PRISM regulations under Alaska Administrative Code, Title 3, Chapter 52 (3 AAC 52) allow water and wastewater utilities to establish a surcharge to recover capital-related costs associated with eligible plants placed in service between general rate cases. AWWU Utility Tariffs will have proposed language to create a new rule incorporating the PRISM regulations as outlined in AAC. The PRISM surcharge will be a tariff rate expressed as a percentage of each customer's billed revenue, applied to all customer classes, and included on the customers' monthly bills as its own line item. PRISM regulations were initiated by the RCA in 2011 through a Rule-making docket, R-11-006.

AWWU has prepared the 2021 Test Year PRISM calculations in accordance with the regulations and practices prescribed 3 AAC 52. As a result of the calculations, the proposed PRISM rate is 1.98% for the Anchorage Water Utility (AWU) and 0.84% for the Anchorage Wastewater Utility (ASU), to be effective January 1, 2023. The proposed PRISM rate will increase a single-family residential customer's bill for water service by \$1.15 and \$0.45 for wastewater service.

The sole driver of the proposed PRISM rates is capital-related costs associated with water and wastewater-eligible plants placed into service in 2021. Operating costs are not included in the PRISM rate calculations. AWWU has not been able to utilize PRISM in prior years primarily because AWWU did not have PRISM-eligible plants placed into service.

All tariff rate changes are subject to the approval of the RCA. Upon Assembly

approval of submission of AWWU's proposed PRISM to the RCA, AWWU intends to request that the PRISM tariff goes into effect on January 1, 2023. The RCA will issue public notice of AWWU's requested PRISM for comment.

Impacts of PRISM

The basic rate components making up an individual's customer bill are customer charges, unmetered usage charges per dwelling unit, metered volumetric charges, meter charges, and fire protection charges. AWWU uses uniform rates for these basic rate components. The proposed PRISM will be applied to the customer's billed revenue (sum of the basic rate components) and will be displayed as an individual line on the customer's bill.

The table below shows the effect of the 2021 Test Year PRISM calculation on current rates for AWWU's most common customer, unmetered single-family residential.

Typical Customer Bill Impacts

Based on the proposed PRISM resulting from 2021 Test Year calculations for AWU and ASU, the single-family residential bill will increase per month for water service by \$1.15, from \$57.97 to \$59.12, and for wastewater service by \$0.45, from \$53.91 to \$54.36. The combined monthly water and wastewater bill for a single-family residential customer will increase by \$1.60, from \$111.88 to \$113.48.

RCA Approval Required

Revenues from the proposed PRISM are included in AWWU's proposed 2023 Operating Budgets. AWWU will file the 2021 Test Year PRISM with the RCA upon Assembly approval by ordinance.

The RCA will notice the filing and proposed PRISM to the public and allow for a thirty-day comment period. The RCA will render a decision on whether to approve the filing or suspend it for further investigation within 45 days of the filing date. If the RCA suspends the filing for further investigation, AWWU will request PRISM be approved on an interim and refundable basis effective January 1, 2023.
