A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FUND BALANCE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHT MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,250,000) TO CONTINUE PROGRAMS APPROVED IN THE PRIORITY AREAS AND FRAMEWORK FOR ALLOCATION OF THE COVID-19 RELIEF FUNDS PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly and the Administration, in their commitment to address the needs of the community during the COVID-19 pandemic, approved multiple economic stimulus and stabilization programs; and

11 **WHEREAS,** throughout 2020, the CARES Act Funds were used to cover some 12 immediate programs and also payroll costs of first responders, which facilitated a 13 change in funding source from CARES Act Funds to Fund Balance for some 14 approved programs; and

WHEREAS, some of the approved programs funded with Fund Balance have not been fully spent and the community needs still exist in 2021; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That an amount not to exceed EIGHT MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,250,000) of Areawide General Fund (101000) Fund Balance is hereby appropriated for the following:

- Risk Pool Insurance Program \$500,000
- Utility Service \$550,000
- Anchorage Health Department \$200,000
- Rental & Mortgage Assistance Program \$6,400,000
- AKHR Cares \$600,000

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
