The Salvation Army Clitheroe Center is a comprehensive substance abuse and dual diagnosis treatment program. We provide professional and affordable treatment services to adults who are addicted to alcohol and/or drugs. Our personalized recovery programs offer clients and their families the opportunity to access services in a residential or outpatient setting.

Our mission is to improve the quality of life for all Alaskans seeking treatment for substance abuse through culturally relevant evidence-based practices to contribute to lifetime recovery.

Residential Rehabilitation

Residential clients (men and women) work individually with a treatment team to identify specific target areas that will be addressed during their stay in rehabilitation groups, individual and family counseling services. The Salvation Army's Clitheroe residential program focuses on dual-diagnosis rehabilitation, treating men and women who are suffering from both serious mental illness & substance abuse. Transitional post-incarceration housing and treatment is also provided to returning citizens.

Outpatient Rehabilitation

Clitheroe Outpatient services are designed for individuals with substance abuse issues that can be effectively addressed outside of a residential program, or aftercare for those who've completed residential treatment. The Outpatient Program provides family services, counseling, and support for those who would benefit from outpatient treatment, have completed inpatient treatment, and need continuing care or are not in need of inpatient treatment.

Clitheroe Outpatient is now offering Adult Drug Information School (ADIS) and Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) classes to those in need.

Alaska Department of Corrections Rehabilitation Services

The Salvation Army Alaska Division and the Alaska Department of Corrections (ADOC) are working together to help incarcerated individuals at Hiland Mountain Correctional Center (HMCC), Goose Creek Correctional Center, and Anchorage Correctional Center fight addiction. The Salvation Army provides rehabilitation services based on the Clitheroe treatment model to help treat incarcerated men and women in need.
