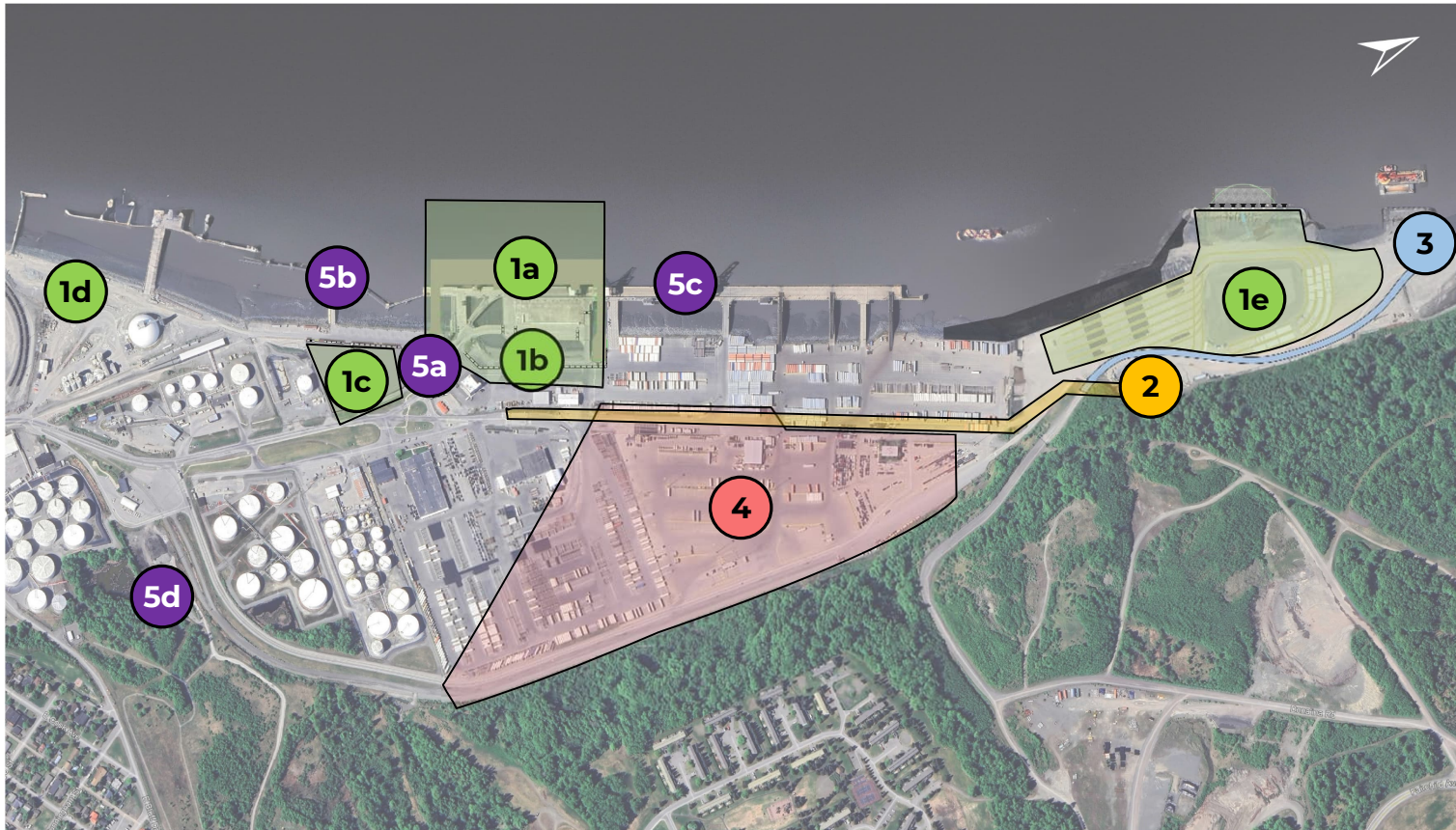

- 6' diameter hole drilled and filled with concrete.





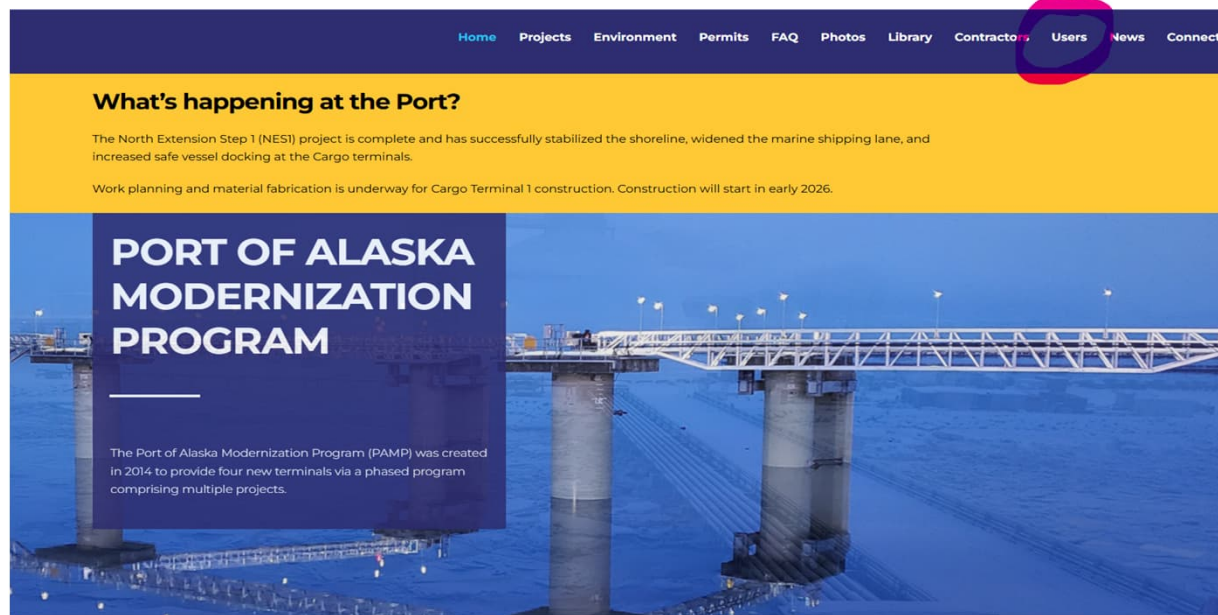
Project schedule

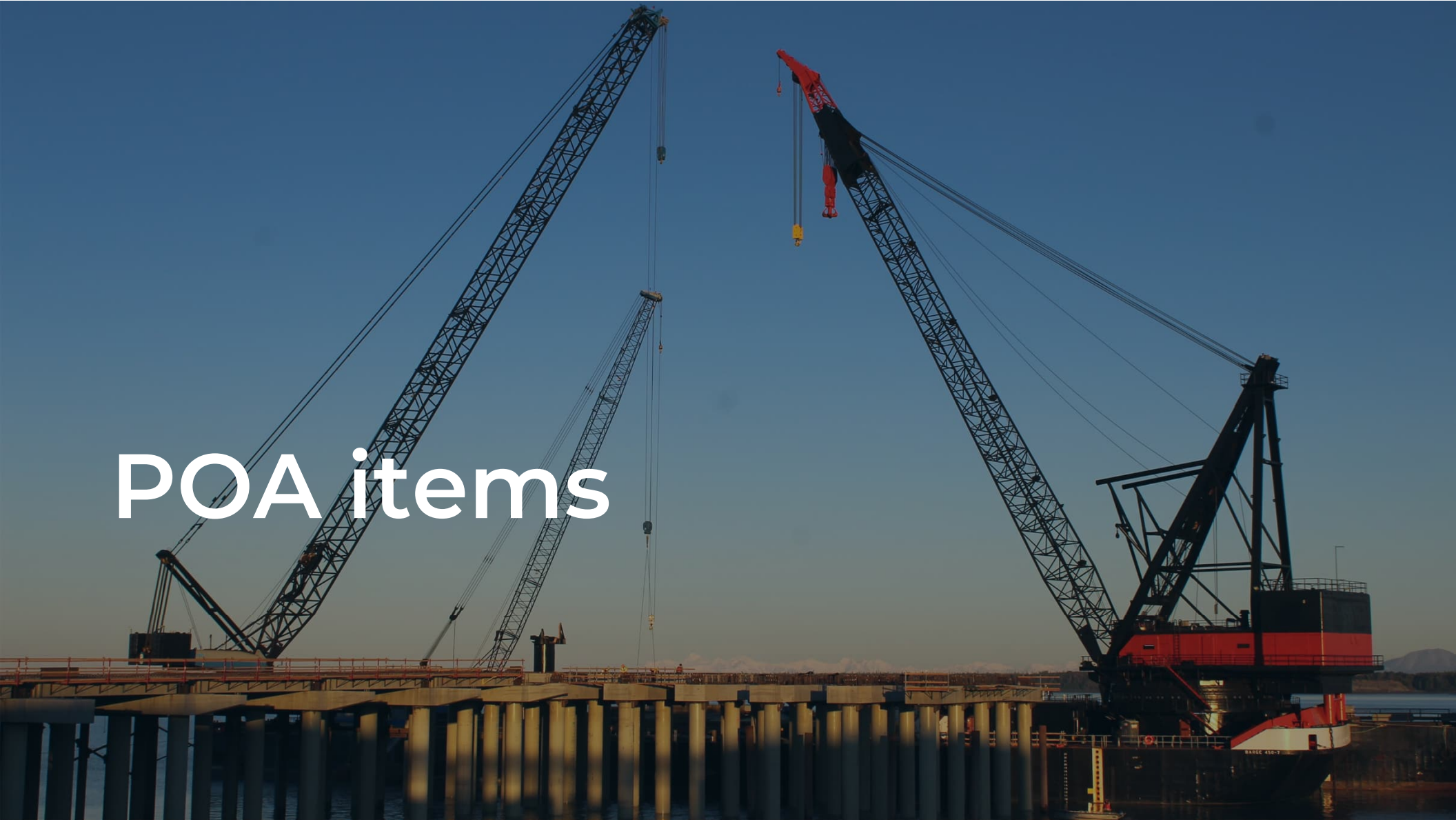
