AWWU Overview

- Municipally Owned
 - AWWU is a department of the MOA
 - AWWU has separate accounting and financial reporting from MOA
 - AWWU is funded by its customers/ratepayers, not taxpayers
- Economically regulated by the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA)
 - Ensures utilities provide safe and adequate services and facilities at just and reasonable rates, terms, and conditions.
 - Alaska Statute requires separate tariffs for each utility-AWU and ASU
 - Any revisions to tariff must be approved by the Assembly and RCA
 - RCA has ultimate jurisdiction of AWU and ASU Tariffs

Rate Changes

- Revenue Requirement Study
 - Determines the level of revenue the Utility needs to cover annual expenses
- Cost of Service Study
 - Identifies how much revenue to collect from each customer class depending on the cost (demand) they put onto AWWU systems (cost causer-cost payer principle)
- Plant Replacement and Improvement Surcharge Mechanism (PRISM)
 - Allows the Utility to recover eligible capital related costs on infrastructure placed into service between filing revenue requirement studies.



Why we chose PRISM

- AWWU's capital improvement plan includes eligible plant where previously it was treatment plant (non-eligible plant)
- Smaller Burden on Ratepayers
 - Rate Increase ~ 5.4%
 - PRISM rate 1.36%
- Less expensive for AWWU
 - General Rate Case expense is approximately \$750k
- Meet all Financial Metrics

Calculations

- Simplified RRS Calculation:
 - + Operating Expenses (2020 actuals including 2021 known/measurable changes)
 - + Depreciation Expense (on Total Non-Contributed Plant Used & Useful as of 12/31/2020)
 - + MUSA Expense (calculated on NBV of <u>Total</u> Plant as of 12/31/2020)
 - + Return on Rate Base (based on capital structure and ROE)
 - = Annual Revenue Requirement

PRISM:

- = Total Annual Eligible Capital Costs divided by Projected Annual Revenue
- Compared to RRS:
 - + Operating Expenses (test year actuals including known/measurable changes)
 - + Depreciation Expense (on Eligible Non-Contributed Plant Used & Useful in 2021)
 - + MUSA Expense (calculated on NBV of Eligible Plant Used & Useful in 2021)
 - + Return on Rate Base (based on capital structure and ROE)
 - = Total Annual Eligible Capital Costs

AWWU Plant Replacement and Improvement Surcharge (PRISM)

AWWU is proposing a modest rate increase for 2023 rates via a modified rate mechanism allowed by the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) known as PRISM. The Plant Replacement and Improvement Surcharge Mechanism (PRISM) regulations are under Alaska Administrative Code: 3 AAC 52, Article 9.

AWWU operates and maintains its water and wastewater infrastructure in a cost-efficient manner to safeguard the public health, maintain environmental compliance and provide reliable water and wastewater services to you, our customers. The need to reinvest in the water and wastewater infrastructure that serves the community is ongoing as the total replacement value of AWWU's aging infrastructure is in the billions of dollars.

To assist with this need, the RCA has regulations to allow utilities to establish a surcharge to recover the costs associated with plant infrastructure additions placed in service between general rate cases through a Plant Replacement Improvement Surcharge Mechanism (PRISM).

Clearly Responsible

PRISM has limitations and is not always eligible for use. When it is eligible for use, it benefits the customers by cutting expenses that go into costly general rate cases, while at the same time ensuring the infrastructure used to deliver customer water and wastewater services are being adequately funded and upgraded in a timely and responsible manner.

As a customer, you can expect to see a charge as a separate line item for each Utility on your water and wastewater bill.

- The initial PRISM rate will be 1.87% for water and 0.81% for wastewater effective on or after January 1, 2023.
- The surcharge will be reset to \$0 on your bill when the next general rate filing is submitted.

PRISM

- Sample bill for a single-family residential water and wastewater customer.
- Per AAC, each Utility must have a separate line for each PRISM rate.
- The surcharge will be reset to \$0 on the customer's bill when the next general rate filing is submitted to the RCA.
