For each committee:

- What has worked well?

- Any big highlights or successes to share with the group?
- Any tips or tricks to share with the group?

For everyone on Assembly:

- Does the Assembly have the right combination of committees and committee membership to meet the Assembly's priorities and goals for the year?
- Are any changes needed this year?
- How is it working to list the relevant items from the Assembly work plan on the back page? Is a different structure needed for tracking projects and goals?
- 2025: Throughout the course of last summer we talked about the creation of a Quality of Life Committee; we now have the staffing available for this committee, is there still interest in creating this committee?

For Administration/Department Directors:

- Do you have adequate channels to get your items heard before an Assembly committee? If no, do you have ideas or suggestions for improvements?
- Does the committee work make the process of moving your items through the Assembly process smoother?
- Do you have suggestions for how to improve your department's involvement in the committees you participate in?
