<b>Total Number of Adults over the age of 25 Served through Housing Surge in Previous Month</b>	277	324	281	506	433	405
<b>Total Number of Adults over the age of 25 Who Secured Housing through Housing Surge and Moved in during Previous Month</b>	31	141	24	30	38	60

Last September over 2,224 single adults were actively experiencing homelessness in Anchorage.

By September 2022, this number had dropped down to **1,482.**<sup>1</sup>



**3 in 10** single adults housed<sup>2</sup>

That is an over 31% decrease in single adult homelessness.

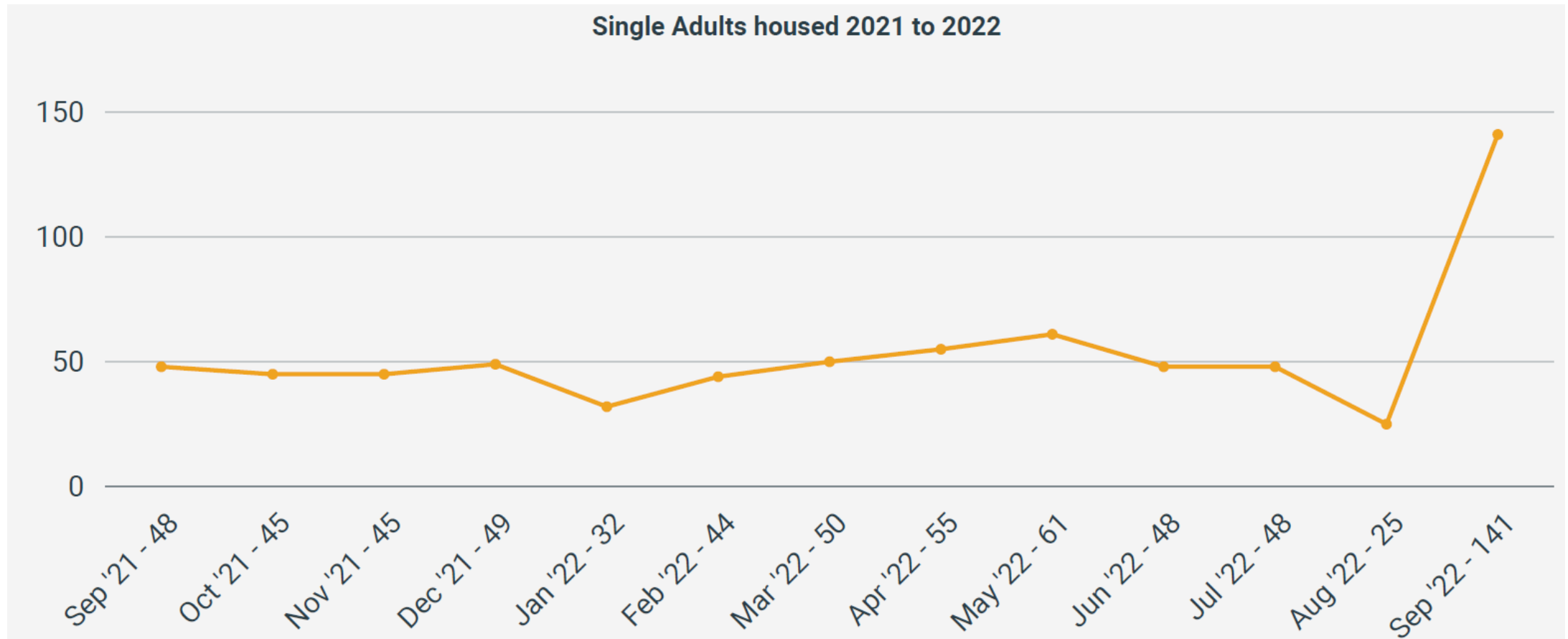
Between September 2021 and 2022, over **691 people were housed.**

The following year over year comparison shows the **drastic decrease** in the number of single adults actively experiencing homelessness.

September 2021: **2,224**

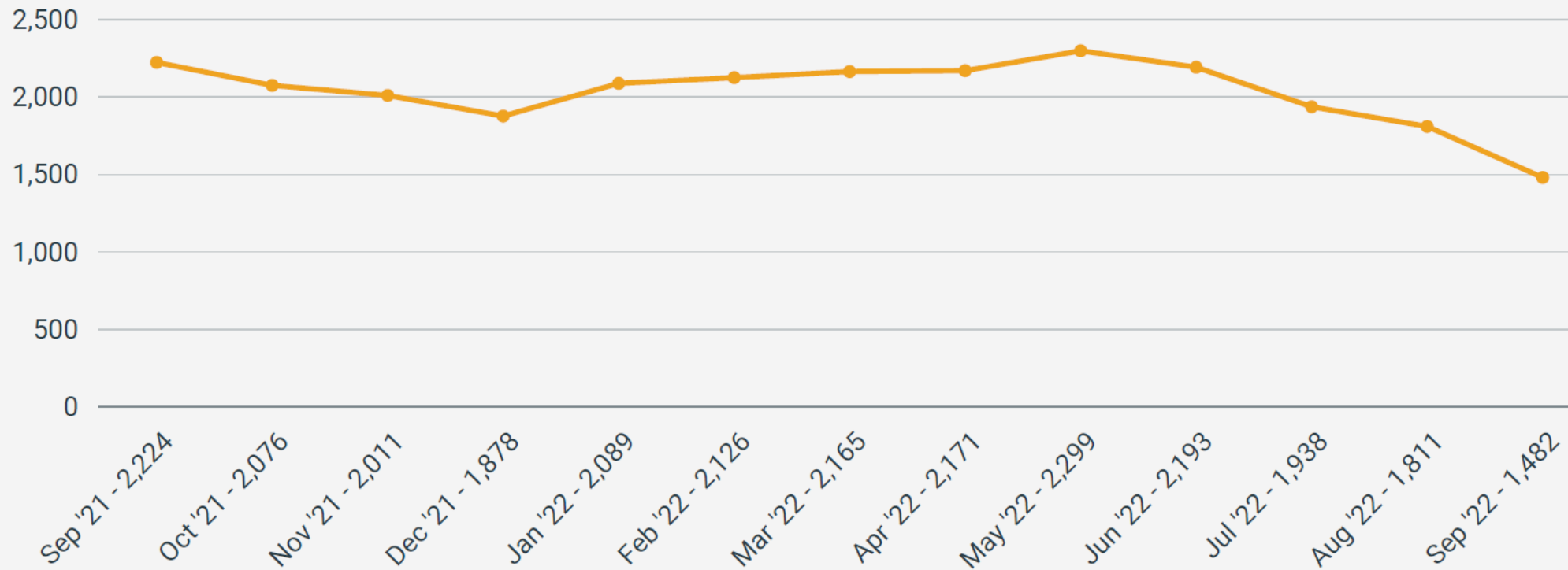
September 2022: **1,482**
