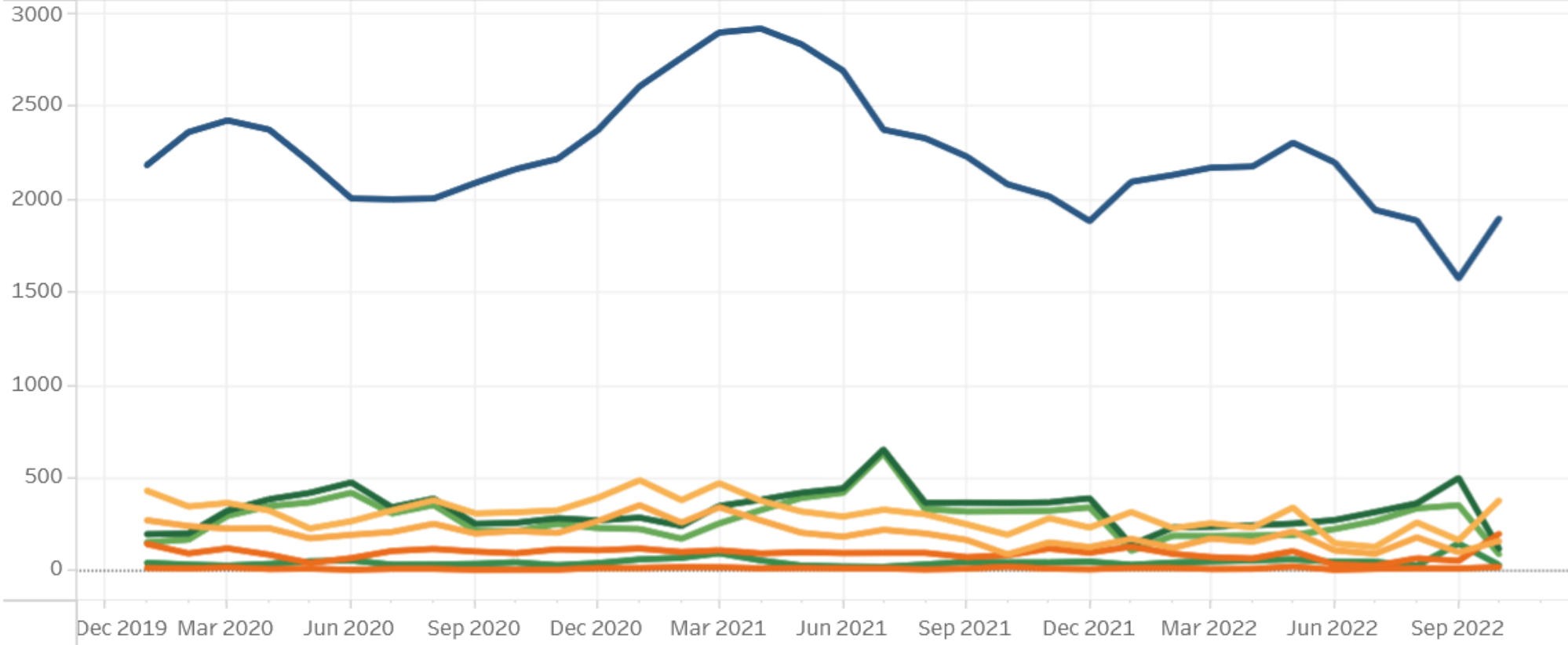
Adults (age 25+) not accompanied by a minor (under 18); includes any veterans and chronic

December H&H Committee Meeting

- Data
 - ACEH's annual gap analysis coming out in early December
 - Gives us an opportunity to either confirm or reconsider priorities
 - Need for some additional shelter
 - Need for additional PSH / low-income housing / workforce housing
- Emergency Shelter Plan from January through April / end of winter
 - Will likely replicate the current plan in use
 - Expecting appropriation with 2022 homelessness alcohol tax funds in December

January through April

- Continued understanding of the gap analysis
- Prepare for demobilization of emergency shelter facilities in April / end of winter
- Focus on housing
 - PSH, low-income housing, extreme low-income housing, workforce housing, affordable housing
 - Policy
 - Funding
 - Community vision

Opportunity to achieve functional zero for single adults (and possibly other populations) if we can focus on and work towards true community solutions.
