All,

The Assembly's Housing and Homelessness Committee will be discussing the issues at Forest Park Mobile Home Park on Wednesday, May 17. The meeting will from 11am to 12:30pm at City Hall, 632 W 6th Ave, in room 155.

As you may know, the Assembly approved AR 2023-152, As Amended, which is attached (the attached version was amended slightly, but not in any way that changes the outcomes expected).

In order to meet the requirement in AR 2023-152, As Amended, for me to provide a report to the full Assembly on this issue by May 25, I'd like to invite you to the meeting on May 17. In order to make the conversation on May 17 as efficient as possible (and hopefully to share good news), I'd like to request the following be considered in advance of the meeting:

- Is there sufficient funding in the current CDBG mobile home repair program to fix the water

and waste disposal for each individual trailer?

- If there is not sufficient funding, can a reallocation take place from CDBG-DR allocated to NeighborWorks? As I understand it, people do not want to relocate and the NeighborWorks program is not a good fit for them.
- Is there any MOA HUD funding available to scale the mobile home repair program to meet the needs of all units?
- Can someone on this email string – AHD, CED, or HUD – reach out and liaison with RurALCAP, who is the current grantee of the mobile home repair program, to get the process started for at least some of the residents?

Please let me know if you have any questions. Otherwise, I'll look forward to seeing you all on May 17 with hopefully good news to report.
