On October 20, the Bronson Administration and the Legislative Drafting Group will host a Town Hall to gather community input on the proposed Mass Care exit strategy and long-term intervention, which was introduced at a community presentation on October 5, 2021.

This Town Hall is the next step in the municipal collaboration to exit the Sullivan Arena and mass care, and systematically bring compassionate care to our residents experiencing homelessness. The strategy involves housing, transitional housing, supportive housing, treatment, and navigation centers among other initiatives. It calls for a ‘no wrong door’ approach with services tailored to individual needs.
