Anchorage Assembly Review of Nominations for Boards and Commission Appointments – November 4

Municipal Boards and Commissions play a vital role in our civic life and are a crucial element in our municipal government. These volunteer bodies assist in a variety of functions, from ensuring that our parks and libraries remain cared for, to overseeing our zoning efforts and advising on the budget.

Each October, the Mayor submits nominations for board and commission appointees for the Assembly to approve. There are currently 83 nominations under consideration – 10 reappointments and 73 new nominations.
