Municipal Officials Announce the Special Election for New Twelfth Assembly Member – June 21, 2022

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

After the adoption of a new Anchorage Assembly district boundary map through the process called Reapportionment, the Assembly called for a Special election to fill the new 12th seat, now known as Seat L. The Special Election will be a mail-in/vote at home election and Election Day is June 21, 2022. This election will apply only to the voters in District 1, the new North Anchorage District, which encompasses Downtown, South Addition, Government Hill, Mountain View, Fairview, Northstar and the northern parts of Spenard, Airport Heights, Russian Jack Park, East and Midtown Anchorage.

Key Deadlines

- May 10: Candidate filing deadline; the entire list of candidates that will appear on the ballot will be posted at <u>muni.org/elections/candidates</u>
- May 22: Last day to register to vote for the Special Election
- May 31: Ballot Packages mailed to qualified Anchorage voters
- June 21: Special Election Day: All Ballot Envelopes (including military and overseas envelopes) must be postmarked on or before Election Day, or returned to a Secure Drop Box or Anchorage Vote Center by 8:00 p.m.

The City Hall Anchorage Vote Center will be open as follows:

- Weekdays, June 13 20, 9 a.m. 6 p.m.
- Saturday, June 18, 10 a.m. 4 p.m.
- Sunday, June 19, noon 5 p.m.
- Election Day, June 21, 7 a.m. 8 p.m.

There will be **five Secure Ballot Drop Box locations**; City Hall Parking Lot, Clark Middle School, Election Center, Fairview Community Rec Center, and West High School.
