Remember to **register to vote** or **update your voter registration** on or before the Sunday, March 2, 2014 deadline.

Register to Vote. Anyone at least seventeen years and nine months old may register, but you must be eighteen years old on April 1, 2014 for your vote to count in the Municipal Election.

Update your Voter Registration. The voter registration application can be found online at <http://www.elections.alaska.gov/ot.php> or call the Alaska Division of Elections at 907-522-8683. It is extremely important to vote in the precinct from which you currently reside and remember to update your registration information to reflect any changes prior to the Election.

Absentee Voting. If you cannot vote in person on Election Day, absentee voting is available by mail, fax, in person, and special needs. Applications for absentee voting by mail and fax can be printed directly from the Municipal Elections website, www.muni.org/elections, or an absentee application can be mailed to you by calling (907) 243-VOTE or by emailing elections@muni.org.

Early Voting. Voting begins March 17, 2014 at City Hall and the Loussac Library with all ballot styles available. Chugiak Senior Center opens on March 24, 2014 with Chugiak/Eagle River ballot styles only.

On Election Day. Election Day, April 1, 2014 you can vote at your precinct. All ballot styles will be available at the Loussac Library, the South Terminal of the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport, and at the UAA Student Center. City Hall and the Chugiak Senior Center are **closed** on Election Day.
