## **ANCHORAGE, ALASKA** AR No. 2023-130

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AUSTIN QUINN-DAVIDSON FOR HER SERVICE AS ACTING MAYOR FROM OCTOBER 2020 TO JULY 2021.

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic hit Anchorage in March 2020 and elected officials and municipal leaders had to act quickly and decisively to safeguard the community; and

**WHEREAS**, amidst the strain of the pandemic, Former Mayor Ethan Berkowitz resigned in October 2020, which required an Assembly Member to fill the vacancy, and the Assembly selected Austin Quinn-Davidson to fill that role; and

WHEREAS, as Acting Mayor, Austin Quinn-Davidson and her family made great sacrifices of their time to perform this service, and like elected officials across the country, faced threats to their safety and wellbeing; and

WHEREAS, as Acting Mayor, Austin Quinn-Davidson made history by becoming the first female and the first openly LGBTQ+ Mayor of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, Austin Quinn-Davidson devoted herself fully to the position and in less than one year, mobilized distribution of a new vaccine, helped steer federal relief funds to local businesses, prioritized rent relief to those suffering from the pandemic's economic impacts, dealt with a local homelessness crisis made worse by the pandemic, and shepherded the city through a contentious mayoral race; and

WHEREAS, as Acting Mayor, Austin Quinn-Davidson strove to ensure consistent and professional communication and collaboration between the executive and legislative branches of the Municipality, including coordination of the COVID-19 response, guidance of the Assembly's Portal to Public Documents project through the IT department, support of the Assembly's annual budget request, and support of the development of the Assembly office space; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly expresses profound gratitude to Austin Quinn-Davidson for serving as Acting Mayor and leading our community through a tumultuous time with thoughtfulness, grace and fortitude.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly honors and recognizes Austin Quinn-Davidson for her service to the Municipality of Anchorage as Acting Mayor from October 2020 to July 2021.
