GET VOTE READY! BALLOT PACKAGES MAIL OUT TODAY!

The Municipal Clerk's Office reminds Anchorage Assembly District 4 (Midtown) voters to get vote ready! Approximately 36,209 ballot packages were mailed today to qualified registered voters in Assembly District 4 for the October 26, 2021 Special Election called following the certification of the petition to recall Assembly Member Meg Zaletel.

Voters in District 4 can anticipate receiving their ballot package in the mail by Monday, October 11, 2021. **To confirm if a voter lives in District 4, visit the Assembly Districts map at www.muni.org/assemblymap and type the residence address into the search field in the upper left corner of the map.** Each ballot package includes the following:

- Official ballot
- Voter Instructions
- Secrecy sleeve (which protects voter privacy)
- Ballot return envelope.

Voters should follow the instructions included in the ballot package and return your ballot in one of three ways:

- Place the ballot return envelope in a Secure Drop Box located within or near Assembly District 4;
- Mail the ballot return envelope by using first class postage through the United States Postal Service; or
- Bring the ballot return envelope to the Anchorage Vote Center at the Loussac Library between October 18 and October 26 (see www.muni.org/elections/AVC for hours).

Be vote ready: Plan ahead, vote and return your mailed ballot as soon as possible. If you don't receive a ballot package, confirm that you live in District 4, and if you do and didn't receive your ballot package by Monday, October 11, call the Voter Hotline at (907) 243-VOTE (8683) or email MOA Elections at elections@anchorageak.gov. Ballots envelopes must be returned to a secure drop box or the Anchorage Vote Center at the Loussac Library, no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, October 26, 2021. Mailed ballot envelopes must be postmarked no later than Election Day, October 26, 2021.
